

#### **Cops Caught Playing Crime Bingo**

When someone is pulled over by law enforcement or engaged somehow by officers, the experience often comes with a surge of adrenaline, even fear, as worry about criminal charges or a mention in the newspaper sets in. Now there's a new concern: Am I being targeted in some sort of inside game the officers are playing? That's what happened in Bozeman, Montana recently where "Crime Bingo" had officers trying to mark off spots on their cards with things like "ARREST 3 PEOPLE OUT OF ONE CAR." and simply "BUTT-ASS NAKED," which was left open to interpretation by players. Thirteen officers, including two sergeants, marked off squares apparently generated by one of several online services catering to the current customized bingo craze, according to the Bozeman Police Department. The secret game came to light and Bozeman Police Chief Jim Veltkamp held a press conference to reveal details about the game, and insisted the rights of those stopped by BPD were not violated as part of the game and added that the game went on for 12 days until someone alerted command staff, who shut down the game. BPD offered no details about whether money was involved, who specifically originated the game or how individual officers were disciplined. The Gallatin County Attorney's Office, the Bozeman City Attorney's Office and the BPD each reportedly conducted internal

After three rounds, the player with the highest score advances to the fast-action Blitz round, where making a bingo in 60 seconds or less wins them \$10,000. The game itself–Bingo Blitz–has been around for more than a decade on Facebook and as a downloadable app on smartphones. Bingo Blitz airs weeknights

#### **Protect Yourself** from Identity Theft

#### Dear Savvy Senior,

I am very concerned about Elon Musk and the so-called DOGE team getting access to my Social Security number and personal financial information through their government office raids. What can I personally do to help protect myself from this identity theft mess? -Worried Senior

#### Dear Worried,

It's a great question! I've been hearing from many older readers around the country that are deeply troubled by the news that the Elon Musk-led Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE) has been granted access to millions of Americans' Social Security records that include highly sensitive personal information.

The major concern among data privacy experts is what could happen if your Social Security number, bank account information or tax records somehow gets leaked or breeched in all the data shuffling. If your information gets in the wrong hands it could lead to identity theft, which means scammers could use your personal information to open credit card accounts, bank accounts, telephone service accounts, and make major purchases-all in your name.

If you're concerned about the privacy of your personal information, the best way to protect yourself is to put a "fraud alert," or better yet a "credit freeze" on your credit file.

A fraud alert is a notification placed on your credit report that signals to potential creditors to take extra steps to verify your identity before extending credit in your name. While a credit freeze completely restricts access to your credit report, essentially preventing anyone from opening new accounts in your name without your explicit authorization.

A credit freeze provides much stronger protection than a fraud alert, but there is a drawback. When you freeze your credit, you

won't be able to open new credit cards or get a new loan while the freeze in place. It does not, however, prevent you from using the credit cards you already have open.

If you do need to get a new credit card or some type of loan, you can always lift the freeze on your account until you get the card or loan approved, and then refreeze it. You'll also be happy to know that a credit freeze is completely free to put in place and lift, as are fraud alerts. And neither action will affect your credit score.

#### FRAUD ALERT SET-UP

To set up a fraud alert, you'll need to contact one of the three major credit reporting bureaus - Equifax, Experian and TransUnion – either by phone, online or by mail. You only need to contact one of these agencies, and they will notify the other two. Here's the phone and website contact information for each of the three bureaus. \* Equifax: 800-685-1111 or Equifax.com/

personal/credit-report-services \* Experian: 888-397-3742 or Experian.

TransUnion: 888-909-8872

or TransUnion.com/credit-help If you haven't been a victim of identity theft, you'll need to set up an "initial fraud alert," which lasts for one year, although you can

renew it for additional one-year periods.

To set up a credit freeze you'll need to contact each of the three previously listed credit reporting bureaus – Equifax, Experian and TransUnion. A credit freeze lasts until you unfreeze it.

But remember, before you apply for new credit card or loan, you'll need to temporarily lift the security freeze by following the procedures from each of the credit reporting bureaus where you placed the freeze.

If, however, you don't want to set up a fraud alert or credit freeze, you can still keep an eye on your credit file by reviewing vour credit report regularly. You can get a free credit report each week from Equifax, Experian and TransUnion by going to AnnualCreditReport.com.



#### Was This Call on the River a Bit too **Optimistic?**

By Jonathan Little

In a recent \$3,500 buy-in tournament at the 200/400/400 level, I raised to 1,000 out of my 50,000 stack with the QdJd in the cutoff. Both of the blinds called, the flop fell Kc10c4c, and my opponents checked to me.

In a multi-way pot, it is somewhat likely that someone has a hand they will not fold, like a pair or a flush draw. While you normally want to bet with your decent draws, it is simply too likely someone will call, so I decided to check.

The turn was the Qs and again my opponents checked to me. At this point, when most recreational live players check, I should have the best hand a decent amount of the time. I do not want to allow a club or jack to come on the river that could easily give one of my opponents the best hand.

I bet 1,500 into the 3,400 pot. Looking back, I think a slightly larger bet of around 2,000 would have been better because it would induce my opponents to fold their junky draws that have a lot of equity, such

Only the small blind, a loose, splashy recreational player, called. The river was the 6c, putting four clubs on the board. To my surprise, the small blind bet 3,500 into the 6,400 pot. This should be a trivially

easy fold because I lose to any flush and any pair better than my middle pair, but it is important to think about how my range appears to my opponent.

When I checked behind on the flop, my opponent should assume that I do not have the Ac. If I do not have the nuts, that drastically decreases the number of hands I can easily call with on the river. I made the assumption that my opponent would bet with the Ac on the turn once the flop checked through. I was also not sure if he would value bet with either the Oc or Jc on the river.

You will find that most players will not value bet with marginal flushes in this spot because they will typically only get called when they are beat. Of course, my opponent could be turning a hand better than mine, such as Kd9d, into a bluff. The idea that neither of us has the nut flush made me think that my opponent should be bluffing much more often than normal, hoping to put me in a tough spot with either a weak flush or a one-pair hand.

Given my pot odds, which dictate that I need to have the best hand 25% of the time or more to profit, I decided to call. I am unsure exactly how often I have the best hand, but I thought I would win more than 25% of the time. Luckily for me, my opponent turned over the Js10s for a bluff, awarding me a


