#### **Sports Betting Goes Live in NC**

After several years of wrangling over a sports betting bill, North Carolina recently became the 38th state, plus Washington, D.C., to allow some form of sports betting and the 30th to offer legal online wagering. The governor signed the bill legalizing sports betting into law last June and the twelve licensees paid \$1 million each to partner with an existing Tar Heel State sports team, sporting venue, and/or Native American tribe; the must also "make efforts to" offer in-person betting. Eight of the twelve went live at press time: Bet365 with partner the Charlotte Hornets; BetMGM/Charlotte Motor Speedway: Caesars/Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians; DraftKings/NASCAR; ESPN BET/Quail Hollow Golf Club (PGA Tour); Fanatics\Carolina Hurricanes; FanDuel/Carolina Panthers; and Underdog/ Sedgefield Country Club (PGA).

#### **Rhode Island Makes Seven**

Online-casino gambling launched recently in Rhode Island, making it the seventh state to offer igaming and the first to launch it since Connecticut in October 2021. Bally's is the sole provider of icasino games in the Ocean State; it also holds the monopoly for brickand-mortar casinos, with one each in Lincoln and Tiverton. The proprietary igaming app features 170 slots and live-dealer blackjack and roulette; the company partnered with Stakelogic, a live-table-game supplier, for its blackjack and roulette software and the technology for its 4,000-square-foot live-game studio in Lincoln. Rhode Island residents must be 21 to play online (only 18 to play in the land-based casinos).

**Suncoast Joins Upgrade Fray** 

#### MGM May Bail

MGM Resorts is looking at selling properties in Ohio and Massachusetts, Bloomberg recently reported, noting the sources said talks are in the early stages and may not lead to transactions. The Vegas-based gaming company took over management of MGM Northfield Park, a racino near Cleveland, from Hardrock International in 2019. MGM Springfield opened in August 2018 as the first traditional casino in Massachusetts. That venue, which generated to the operator's expectations. "Our original valuation of this market simply was off full stop," said MGM CEO Bill Hornbuckle in a press briefing. The Massachusetts venue cost the operator \$960 million to build. MGM sold the real estate assets to MGM Growth Properties (MGP) for \$400 million in 2021. VICI Properties (NYSE: VICI) acquired MGP for \$17.2 billion that same year, gaining control of the property assets of MGM Northfield Park and the Springfield casino, among other MGM venues. Likely because talks are in the early stages, potential buyers for the operating rights of the pair of MGM casinos haven't been publicly floated.


# **VP Playing Options**

Many video poker players think they know their playing strategy cold. However, where they miss the boat is not recognizing all the playing options in a hand before they decide which cards to hold. For example, suppose you are playing 9/6 Jacks or Better and are dealt the following hand. Which cards would you hold?

The above hand is an example of how options; the suited J-K of hearts (i.e., players tend to focus only on the high cards two-card royal flush) and the consecutive in their hand. They immediately make a decision on which high cards to hold and then hit the draw button. In addition, many flush (8-9-10) has a higher expected value players view the Ace as a high card only. (3.00 ER) than the two suited high cards when, in fact, it could be used as a low (2.98 ER). It's a close call, but holding the card (and part of an Ace low, three-card suited 8-9-10 is slightly better than holding straight flush).

Here are two tips that could help you avoid the costly mistake of not recognizing option that most players miss. That's all the options in your hand.

1) When you initially look at the cards EV for the latter is 3.72, making this the in your hand and hit the hold buttons under the cards that you believe are the best playing option, train yourself to look at the hand one more time to be sure you haven't missed another playing option.

2) Practice playing video poker at home on your computer, using a video poker training software. The program will alert you when you make an incorrect play (that includes "missing" a playing option). This type of training will help you recognize all the playing options in each hand. (The two software programs that I recommend are Video Poker for Winners, and Optimum Video Poker.)

Lastly, if you slow down your play and, in addition, take frequent breaks (at least stand and stretch once an hour), this will help keep your mind fresh and focused on recognizing all the playing options in every hand.




### **Pricey Purses**

**DEAR PAWS:** My little dog Barnsey is quite a barker for a terrier, but for the past several days his bark has been very hoarse. He sometimes snorts or sneezes, too. I make sure he has plenty of water, but I'm not sure what else to do. It doesn't seem to be getting better. — Faye H., Hartford

**DEAR FAYE:** This is a perfect time to take Barnsey to the vet. Chronic hoarseness when barking can have several different causes, and the veterinarian can better evaluate him to see what's happening.

I'll go over some of the reasons for a barker suddenly getting hoarse. Laryngitis is a common diagnosis, but it's important to figure out the cause. A bacterial or viral infection may be the culprit, or gastroesophageal reflux.

Less common causes are masses or tumors growing on or near the dog's larynx, or other conditions affecting the larynx. These may require surgery, and the vet will discuss this

The vet will evaluate Barnsey to see if he has an infection, acid reflux, or if the hoarse barking has another cause. They'll then be able to recommend an effective treatment. For example, a bacterial infection would likely be treated with antibiotics. A viral infection has to run its course, but Barnsey would be treated with medications to make

him comfortable and reduce inflammation. If acid reflux is the suspected culprit, the vet may recommend changes to his feeding schedule and the amount of food at each meal. You can also try different varieties of

#### **Playing Poker Out of Position is Difficult**

I recently played a hand in a \$3,500 buyin poker tournament that demonstrates a tricky situation that many players approach incorrectly

Early on Day 2 with blinds at 1,500/3,000 with a 3,000 big blind ante, a somewhat tight, aggressive kid raised to 7,000 from second position. The player in fourth position and the button called, and I decided to call 4,000 more out of my 125,000-effective stack from the big blind with the 9s6s9. The flop came Qc7s2s giving me a flush draw. I checked because I will have no leading range on this board that should be good for the initial raiser. The initial raiser bet 18,000 into the 32,500 pot. Only the button called. At this point, I thought the initial raiser must have a reasonably strong hand to continuation-bet into three players, even on this somewhat dry board. I assumed the button would call with most of his onepair hands as well as his flush draws. I had 118,000 left in my stack. So, what should I

Folding is out of the question unless both opponents are thought to be extremely tight because, even though I could be crushed by a better flush draw, most of the time my draw will be live.

When you have a draw and are getting decent immediate pot odds, calling is rarely a mistake. If I was facing a larger bet, perhaps 26,000 into the 32,500 pot, calling would become a worse option. The main problem with calling is that if I hit my draw on the turn, I will have a difficult time extracting value because I am out of position and I will not have the nuts. Notice that if I improve to a flush and lead into my opponents and face a raise, my flush will shrivel into a bluff catcher. If I check and it checks through, I have to dodge another spade on the river. If someone bets the turn, I can only checkcall, again having to dodge a spade. Playing draws from out of position is difficult!

Raising small, perhaps to 44,000, is not a good idea because it will frequently induce my opponents to call, which may induce them to call my small turn all-in shove with an overly wide range. When you have a junky draw and decide to play it aggressively, you want to ensure you can

make your opponent's fold. Going all in seems like a reasonable option, especially if I can make my opponents fold marginal top pairs and better flush draws. Going all in to some extent ensures that most of the time when I get called my outs will After some thought, I decided that going

all in would lead to the best result for me. The initial raiser called with pocket sevens for the middle set, and I was out of the tournament when the Qs came on the turn, completing my flush, but also his full house. After discussing this situation with a few of my friends, I now think calling the flop bet is ideal, mainly because I am getting decent pot odds to see one more card and it decreases the odds I go broke. Minimizing the odds you go broke is a skill you must master if you want to succeed at poker tournaments. Although I gave myself the best chance to win this specific pot, I also opened the door to go broke, which lead to disaster this time.





### **Small Punishments** for Scammers



Why, one wonders, would he only be in line for five short years in the slammer? Yes, there could be a hefty fine, but it's the time behind bars that would keep society safe.

## Casino Q&A

Ever wondered where the terms one-armed bandit, blackjack, and jackpot came from? Here's the history behind some of the common terms used in today's gambling

BINGO: In the U.S., Bingo was originally called "Beano" and was commonly played at county fairs and carnivals. A caller would draw numbered discs from a cigar box, and players would use beans to cover the numbers that were called out. The lucky player would yell "Beano!" The prize: a small Kewpie doll.

In December of 1929, New York toy salesman Edwin S. Lowe happened to watch a game of Beano being played at a carnival near Jacksonville, GA. During the game a winner accidentally yelled "Bingo!" instead of "Beano!" Seeing the game's potential as a crowd pleaser and money maker, Lowe changed the name of the game from Beano to Bingo. And with the help of a math professor from Columbia University, Lowe made Bingo the game we know today.

BLACKJACK: The game is believed to be of French origin and was brought to America by French colonists in the early 1800s. It was called vingt-et-un, meaning 21.

The game wasn't very popular, so some gambling houses paid a bonus if a two-card 21 was made up of an ace and a jack of either clubs or spades. The black jack was the key to the bonus and hence became the name of

JACKPOT: Slot machine is actually short for nickel-in-the-slot machine, which was a coin-operated gaming device found in saloons and cigar stores in San Francisco in the 1890s. Prizes consisted of one or more cigars or drinks at the bar. Then the nickelin-the-slot was designed to pay out real coins as prizes, sometimes called jack, a slang term for money—like dough, mullah, and



### Special Mom, **Special Recipe**

My mother was a wonderful cook. Our house was the place for all the big family gatherings. On Thanksgiving she would make so much homemade cornbread later. dressing that it eventually took two of us, 6. My sister-in-law made this for my birthday last year, and that was one of the best birthdays I've had in a long time.


#### MAMA'S CHICKEN SPAGHETTI

- 3 cups shredded or chopped cooked chicken
- 12 oz. spaghetti, broken into 2-inch pieces 28 oz. (2 cans) low sodium chicken broth plus water (to cook the spaghetti)
- ½ stick butter (4 Tablespoons)
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 2 cans Campbell's Condensed Cream of Mushroom soup
- 1 teaspoon Lawry's Seasoned Salt, OR ½ teaspoon onion powder plus ½ teaspoon garlic powder
- Salt and Pepper to taste
- 8 oz. cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Bring chicken broth and water to a boil in a saucepan to cook pasta.
- 3. Break spaghetti into approximately 2-inch pieces.
- 4. Cook pasta in the broth according to
- directions on package. 5. Reserve some of the cooking broth for
- 7. Melt butter in a large skillet or Dutch
- oven over medium heat. 8. Add onions and cook until soft and tender
- 9. Add soup, Lawry's Seasoned Salt, cooked shredded chicken, and some of the reserved cooking broth - maybe 1/3 cup (can add more later if needed) to the skillet.

Note: If using a Dutch oven (step 7), you can skip the casserole dish and oven, and simply add the cheese to the dish at the end. The cheese won't have the same texture as ovenbaking will give it, but the taste is almost identical. However, the casserole dish makes a nicer presentation.

I hope you have a chance to try this recipe someday. You can lighten it by using a little less butter, lower sodium/lower fat soup, or cutting back (or even omitting) the cheese. Make it yours.


