Extracting Full Value on the River

I recently played a hand from a \$3,500 buy-in poker tournament that illustrates a few key concepts you must master if you want to succeed at no-limit hold 'em, such as adjusting to your opponents' tendencies and not being afraid to go for value on the river.

Early in Day 1 with blinds at 75/150, everyone folded to me in the cutoff and I raised to 400 out of my 30,000 effective stack with Kh-Qd. This raise is perfectly fine and standard. There really are no other options besides raising a bit larger or smaller. Only a loose, splashy recreational player called from the small blind.

The flop came Ah-Qs-9c, giving me middle pair. My opponent checked.

At this point, the two reasonable options are to check or bet small, about 30% pot. Considering that my opponent will call with too many hands both preflop and postflop, I prefer continuation betting.

There is simply too much value to be had from this type of player. Against decent players though, you should strongly consider checking behind with your weak aces and middle pairs, as well as with some junk. That way, you can easily call turn and river bets with the aces, call turn bets with the queens, and fold to a turn bet with the junk. This strategy will result in you being decently balanced and difficult to exploit.

I bet 400 into the 950 pot and my opponent called. The turn was the 4d and my opponent checked.

As on the flop, both checking and betting small are reasonable options. While I would check essentially every time against a strong player, there may still be some value to extract from a splashy opponent who will call a small turn bet with any pair or draw. However, checking behind may induce bluffs, allowing me to easily call most river bets. As your opponent will be more inclined to bluff the river with all their unpaired hands, you should be more inclined to check behind on the turn.

I checked behind. The river was the Ks and my opponent bet 400 into the 1,750 pot.

A common tendency of recreational players is to make small river bets with marginal made hands when the turn checks through, hoping to extract value while keeping the pot manageable. So, how does my middle two-pair fare against marginal value hands? Most likely, my opponent has a weak ace. Knowing that, I should certainly raise for value. If my opponent surprises me and re-raises, I can then fold, making the assumption that my read must have been incorrect. Be sure to consider how much your specific opponent will be willing to call with a weak ace. If they are the type of player who will only call a tiny raise, making it 1,100 may be ideal. If they are an extreme calling station, you can make it large, perhaps 3,000.

Not knowing anything about my opponent's river tendencies, I elected to raise to 2,000. My opponent thought for about three minutes before calling and then mucking in disgust after I turned my hand up. He had an ace and was apparently angry that I "got lucky" on him.

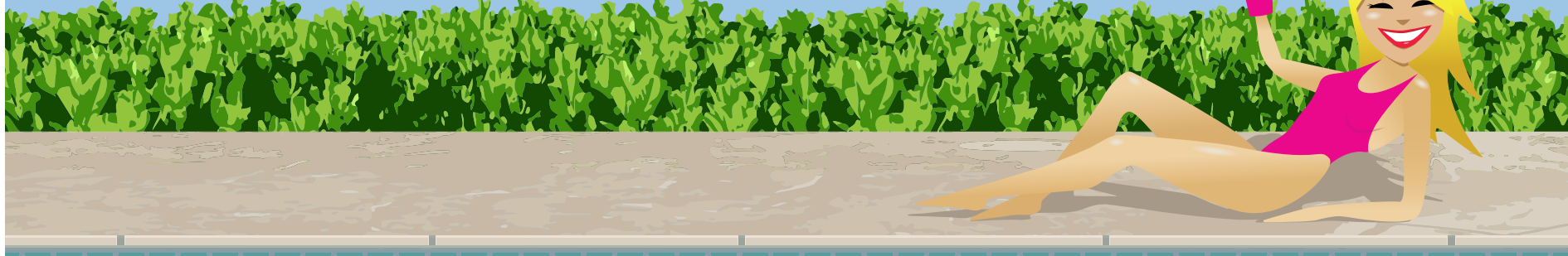

Our local Bingo hall saves one day of the late spring for kids. They come in a group of about thirty from the elementary school accompanied by five mothers to keep the peace. We were asked to attend to help with the play and prize distribution.

The kids, who are nine and ten, cannot play for money, but they do get nice prizes such as movie tickets, free meals, and store gift certificates. They are as excited as if their prizes were in the millions.

We had arranged for the balloon lady to come also and each of the kids got to choose a balloon with a Bingo pattern imprinted on it. If any of the kids won with the pattern they had selected they got a double prize.

The games were kept relatively simple, such as regular Bingo, chevron or four corners, but I think those kids could have figured out the most complicated of patterns. When one of them was on

the excitement and encouragement ran rampant. I especially liked the way they gave encouragement to each other or to someone who didn't win anything last time.

We used our supply of hard cards and each child got two. They could swap with each other or with the reserve supply, but no games were held up for the swapping and the kids quickly learned to be ready.

Bryan, a Downs Syndrome child, was in the group this year and I had thought he would require a lot of supervision. This, however, proved not to be true as he was very self-sufficient. He also seemed to help quiet the noisy, excited children while they unobtrusively kept an eye on his cards and made sure he didn't miss any numbers.

Marva, a bright-eyed beauty with carrot red hair was the first child to have a chance of winning with her balloon imprinted pattern. She had chosen a diagonal and bounced on her chair with excitement as each number was called. At last her number was called and she won not one, but two free meals at the local Mexican restaurant. Several of her table mates volunteered to go to dinner with her, but she just grinned and said we'd have to wait and see.

We had a few bad moments while Josh crammed too big a bite of hot dog into his mouth, choked and coughed it into his hand.

Ben, a small, dark-eyed charmer was the only one in the group to win twice and he was loudly berated for his stupid luck. "I'm always lucky," he told me with a heart-melting smile. "I won a diving contest at camp last month and Mom says she's maybe gonna let me pick her lotto numbers."

When Bryan got "on" for a double Hollywood, the whole room rooted for

him. He said, "I just need G-50. That's how old my Dad is and it's my best number." We all rooted for him and when it came up, there were shouts of joy. I happened to be looking at Marva's cards when Bryan won and noticed she had been "on" for the same number. She quietly cleared her card without claiming a win, then looked up to see me watching. "I already won," she said. "Nobody needs to be greedy."

New Game Room Regs

At its peak, the operators of Bingoland in Corpus Christi, Texas say business was so good they were able to donate \$50,000 to charities every three months. Currently, general manager Justin Aguilar says, it's hard to make any contribution at all. He blames the rise in popularity of game rooms—unregulated businesses, where people play slot machine-style games—for the reduction in his business. But Aguilar is hopeful that the regulations the Nueces County Commissioners Court approved with a recent game room ordinance will level the playing field when it comes to drawing in customers. "With these new regulations being put in place, it will give us a fighting chance to stay open to benefit our charities," he said. The regulations include game rooms not being able to locate themselves within 1,500 feet of a school, church, or neighborhood, limited hours of operation, and being subjected to a permitting process designed to protect customers' health and safety. At press time a date had not been set for the regulations to take effect.

Double Bingo!

Two Las Vegas locals collectively won \$41,627 in one day playing Bingo at Arizona Charlies this past April. Shentille won \$35,263 after hitting the Double Progressive in 32 numbers during the 9 a.m. session. The second winner, Pedro, won \$6,364 after hitting the Ace Ball jackpot at 1 p.m.

Candy Bar Bingo a Hit

Family fun was back on the calendar in Barnegat, New Jersey recently with more than 100 people enjoying a Thursday

evening of Candy Bar Bingo. Barnegat Recreation Department's Special Needs division and the Meadowedge Social Club worked together to bring the event to the community, and according to Barnegat Recreation Director Jean Broadbent, 114 people registered in advance at the cost of \$5 per family. The crowd who filtered in to play Bingo was a mix of children and adults. Committeeman Albert "Al" Bille serves as the liaison to the recreation department and was asked to call the first two of the Bingo games. "It made me happy to see so many residents out having a good time," Bille said. "I'm glad that we're finally able to plan family events again." Funding for the event came from a special grant that included enough money to give out a total of fifteen baskets stuffed with candy.

Bingo musical Has a Run

A joyous atmosphere pervaded a recent rehearsal of *Bingo! The Winning Musical* at Olympic Theatre Arts, in Sequim, Washington, where actors and production staff laughed and joked with each other as they prepared the musical comedy for local audiences. The show utilizes a single evocative set—designed by Sandy Altman—to tell the story of four women friends who love to play Bingo, employing flashbacks and songs to tell a story of misunderstandings and love. "It's very joyful and very fun," said director Kyle LeMaire, who moved to the North Olympic Peninsula from New York City two years ago. Production manager Lorra Cornet explained that each member of the audience gets a Bingo card and play three games of Bingo during the course of the show, and winners receive a prize.

Interestingly, the top five involved only three performers, with Elton John occupying rankings 5 and 3 and Celine Dion taking numbers 1 and 2. Over the seven years of his “Million Dollar Piano” residency (2011-2018), Elton grossed \$131.2 million, while over the five years of his “Red Piano” stint (2004-2009), it was \$166.4 million. “Celine,” which ran from 2011 to 2019, earned \$292.2 million, while appropriately, the original “A New Day” (2003-2007), which launched all the residencies that followed, took in \$385.1 million. All four residencies happened at the Colosseum at Caesars Palace. Placing in the fourth slot was Britney Spears’ “A Piece of Me” (2013-2017) at Planet Hollywood, grossing \$137.7 million.

Anniversary Hors d'oeuvres

Dear Ask Annie,

My parents are celebrating their 25th Wedding Anniversary this summer. I need two good recipes; one for a shrimp hors d'oeuvre and one for a crab hors d'oeuvre. I love all of your suggested recipes. Please pick two good ones for me. Thanks.

Dear Sonya,

Here are two of my favorite recipes. Congratulations to your parents! —Annie

PICKLED SHRIMP

- ½ cup virgin olive oil
- ½ cup red wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons capers
- 2 ½ teaspoons celery seed
- ¼ teaspoon hot red pepper
- 4 bay leaves
- 1 large garlic clove
- 2 lbs. cooked, peeled medium or large shrimp
- 1 large onion, thinly sliced into rings

In a large bowl, whisk the oil and vinegar together, stir in the capers, celery seed, hot pepper flakes, bay leaves and garlic. Stir in the shrimp and the onion rings, cover and marinate the shrimp for at least a day, stirring occasionally. To serve, drain, arrange on a platter, and provide toothpicks.

MARYLAND CRAB CAKES

- 2 lbs. backfin crabmeat
- 1 cup fine breadcrumbs
- 6 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1 whole egg, lightly beaten
- 2 egg whites, lightly beaten
- 2 tablespoons minced parsley
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 4 green onions, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons melted butter

Pick over the crabmeat and remove any bits of shell and cartilage; lightly mix the crabmeat with the breadcrumbs. In a medium sized bowl, mix the mayonnaise, mustard, egg, egg white, parsley, Worcestershire sauce and green onion and fold carefully into the crabmeat so that nice chunks of crabmeat remain. Share into 2 dozen small crab cakes. Cover and refrigerate. To serve, heat the butter in a nonstick skillet and sauté the crab cakes on both sides until they are golden brown, about 3 minutes total. You may have to do them in several bunches.
