


Extracting Full Value on the River By Jonathan Little

I recently played a hand from a \$3,500 buy-in poker tournament that illustrates a few key concepts you must master if you want to succeed at no-limit hold 'em, such as adjusting to your opponents' tendencies and not being afraid to go for value on the river.

everyone folded to me in the cutoff and I raised to 400 out of my 30,000 effective stack with Kh-Qd. This raise is perfectly fine and standard. There really are no other options besides raising a bit larger or smaller. Only a loose, splashy recreational player called from the small blind.

middle pair. My opponent checked. At this point, the two reasonable options are to check or bet small, about 30% pot.

with too many hands both preflop and postflop, I prefer continuation betting.

There is simply too much value to be had from this type of player. Against decent players though, you should strongly consider checking behind with your weak aces and middle pairs, as well as with some junk. That way, you can easily call turn and river bets with the aces, call turn bets with the queens, and fold to a turn bet with the junk. This strategy will result in you being decently balanced and difficult to exploit.

I bet 400 into the 950 pot and my opponent called. The turn was the 4d and my opponent checked.

As on the flop, both checking and betting small are reasonable options. While I would check essentially every time against a strong player, there may still be some value to extract from a splashy opponent who will call a small turn bet with any pair or draw. However, checking behind may induce bluffs, allowing me to easily call most river bets. As your opponent will be more inclined to bluff the river with all their unpaired hands, you should be more inclined to check behind on the turn.

I checked behind. The river was the Ks and my opponent bet 400 into the 1,750 pot

A common tendency of recreational players is to make small river bets with marginal made hands when the turn checks through, hoping to extract value while keeping the pot manageable. So, how does my middle two-pair fare against marginal value hands? Most likely, my opponent has a weak ace. Knowing that, I should certainly raise for value. If my opponent surprises me and re-raises. I can then fold. making the assumption that my read must have been incorrect. Be sure to consider how much your specific opponent will be willing to call with a weak ace. If they are the type of player who will only call a tiny raise, making it 1,100 may be ideal. If they are an extreme calling station, you can make it large, perhaps 3,000.

PICKLED SHRImP

- ¹/₂ cup virgin olive oil
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup red wine vinegar
- 2 tablespoons capers
- $2\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons celery seed
- ¹/₄ teaspoon hot red pepper
- 4 bay leaves
- 1 large garlic clove
- 2 lbs. cooked, peeled medium or large shrimp
- 1 large onion, thinly sliced into rings

In a large bowl, whisk the oil and vinegar together, stir in the capers, celery seed, hot pepper flakes, bay leaves and garlic. Stir in the shrimp and the onion rings, cover and marinate the shrimp for at least a day, stirring occasionally. To serve, drain, arrange on a platter, and provide toothpicks.

mARYLAND CRAB CAKES

- 2 lbs. backfin crabmeat
- 1 cup fine breadcrumbs
- 6 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1 whole egg, lightly beaten
- 2 egg whites, lightly beaten
- 2 tablespoons minced parlsey
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce 4 green onions, finely chopped
- 2 tablespoons melted butter

Pick over the crabmeat and remove any bits of shell and cartilage; lightly mix the crabmeat with the breadcrumbs. In a fold carefully into the crabmeat so that nice chunks of crabmeat remain. Share into 2 dozen small crab cakes. Cover and refrigerate. To serve, heat the butter in a nonstick skillet and sauté the crab cakes on both sides until they are golden brown, about 3 minutes total. You may have to do them in several bunches.
