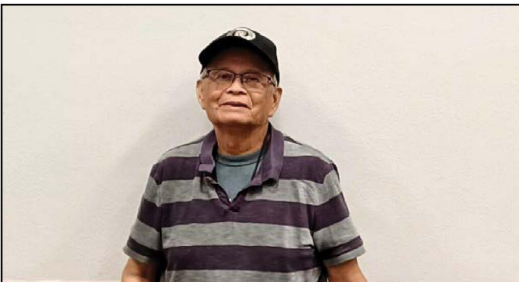

## Casino Q&A

### Understanding the RNG

Q. People are always talking about the RNG when they talk about slot machines. And some people say they are winning or losing cycles. Can you explain the RNG and whether there is such a thing as a winning cycle?

A. The Random Number Generator (RNG) is the brain of the machine. While most players know that there is a computer chip picking the numbers, they don't fully understand how it works and this can lead to some of the many myths and misconceptions about a slot machine. One of the most common myths is that a machine has a cycle that can let a player know when it is due to hit. Many "Snake Oil Salesmen" will try to sell you a system for doing just that. Save your money – it can't be done.

The RNG program is a microprocessor similar to the one in your home computer. Instead of running Word or Excel, it runs a special program, the RNG, that generates numbers to correspond to the symbols on the reel of the slot machine.

You might say that the RNG is in perpetual motion. As long as there is power to the machine it is constantly selecting numbers. The RNG generates a value between 0 and 4 billion (approximately number) which is then translated into a specific set of numbers to correspond to the symbols on the reels. The outcome of each spin is determined by the number selected by the RNG. This number is then used to spin the spin button or deposit coin.

The RNG uses a formula known as an algorithm which is a series of instructions for generating the numbers. The scope of this is beyond most of our mathematical knowledge but can be checked for accuracy. This is done by the Casino Control Board and other testing laboratories to make sure that the program performs as it should so the player will not be cheated.

**Principles of the Random Number Generator**

There is a more simplified explanation that's easier to relate to. Although this is not precisely how the RNG operates, it should give you a basic understanding of the principles of how the winning spins are determined.

Real time slot machines have a number of spaces on each reel that contain a symbol or blank. These are referred to as the physical stops. Modern slots have between 22 physical stops. For our purposes, let's imagine that there are only 10 stops on each reel. With 10 stops there can be 1,000 different combinations. We get this number by multiplying the number of symbols on each reel (10 x 10 x 10 = 1,000). The 1,000 combinations that can be attained are known as a cycle, and this is the word that sometimes confuses a player into thinking that the machine has cycles of winning and losing.

The odds of a three-number combination being picked are one in a demand. Theoretically, if you play 1,000 spins you should see each of these number combinations once. However, we all know that this is not the case. If you played a million spins you would see that the numbers would even out to be closer to the actual probability. This is similar to flipping a coin 100 times. Although the odds are 50-50 you are unlikely to see 50 heads and 50 tails after 100 flips.

## How to Find Volunteers

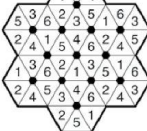
**Hi Guy:**  
We're having trouble with recruiting volunteers for Bingo and wondered if you had any ideas. The Bingo is sponsored by a high school PTSA and generates money for various student school activities.

**Hi Vince,**  
If you're a PTSA, I would assume that the volunteer workers you currently have are parents and teachers. If you are looking to expand your volunteer workforce beyond that, I have several suggestions.  
First, find grandparents and students (if state law allows). Grandparents who are retired

may have the extra time and interest in getting involved with your Bingo. It would be a real incentive for them to know that they are educating their grandchildren's education and life experience. As far as tapping the students, I think this is a non-problem. Parents invest so much time and energy in raising their kids that I think sometimes they become kind of opportunistic for their kids to do something for themselves.  
Grandparent, retired folks may also be looking for ways to be of service, so be sure to check in at your local senior center.  
Reach out to social and professional clubs, campus-based sororities and fraternities, membership groups, and community groups. All of these can be excellent volunteer resources.  
There are also sites online, like VolunteerMatch.com, that could prove useful, and resources to help you to recruit the volunteers you do have.  
Finally, let players themselves. If you let them know that your organization needs volunteers to keep the game alive, perhaps a few would like to step up on occasion and help out.  
The bottom line is, charity bingo needs volunteers to survive, so finding them, and keeping them, can be a top priority for everyone who loves the game. —Guy

Yield: 14 to 15 cookies  
Total Time: 35-40 minutes

- 14 macaroons sweetened shredded coconut
- 4 macaroons unsweetened condensed milk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 3 egg whites, at room temperature
- 1/4 teaspoon kosher salt
- Optional: 1/2 cup chocolate chips for dipping

**Preheat the oven to 325 F. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.**

In a large bowl, combine the coconut, condensed milk, and vanilla. In a separate bowl, whip the egg whites and salt until firm peaks using a stand mixer or hand mixer on high speed. Use a spoon to fold the egg whites into the coconut mixture in three stages, mixing gently and preventing deflation.

Drop mounds of batter onto your prepared sheet pan using either a ice cream scoop or two spoons. Space them with most hands to prevent sticking. There is no top shape for a macaroon. If you're making them, press your thumb or a wine cork into each cookie to make an indentation.

Bake for 25 to 30 minutes, until golden brown. Cool and serve.

To dip and drizzle with chocolate, net the cookies in the microwave. Dip the cookie as desired.

### Super Bad Blackjack Advice

Several years ago, I wrote an article that caused consternation about blackjack that originated from players, dealers, and even the Internet. I thought I had heard and read all the nonsensical misconceptions about blackjack that have been passed on or written over the past 50 years; however, I was wrong, dead wrong.

That's because I recently received a print magazine published in the USA for casino players that contained an article on blackjack strategy, which floored me.

The author wrote about a "new golden rule" that had made a big difference in how I play from a strategic point of view." Here is one of the author's "wisdoms":

"To get started, you need to understand that it is a fact that each player at a blackjack table has a significant role to play in the game will go. The first thing to consider when taking a seat at a blackjack table is where you want to sit and what responsibility you

want to hold at the table. The first seat (first base) and last seat (third base) of the table pretty much determine the way the game will go down. If these two players do not know the basic strategy rules of the game, the odds will be altered for every player at the table." The author continues with more incredibly wrong advice, such as the following: "I've already seen the time for the whole table. If the dealer has anything between 5 and 6 showing, the table should not take any unnecessary cards that could end up being the dealer's bust card needed for the dealer."

To say I was flabbergasted about what the author had written, and the publisher who published it, is an understatement. I also felt sorry for blackjack players who read this article believing the above "strategic advice" was accurate. I've already emailed the publisher of the magazine about the article, but I intend to state the facts about what a player should know before taking a seat at a blackjack table.

Let me begin with the misconception that players who assign their hands (i.e., do not use the basic playing strategy) will "alter the odds for every player." The fact is that this is a complete lie. The odds of the game are not a team sport. In the long run, the bad play of other players does not affect the home edge against you.

Doesn't believe me? Take a gambler at the dealer's table who is not a blackjack expert, but who plays by two different blackjack experts.

My friend Michael Schackler, who is recognized internationally as an expert on the mathematical analysis of casino games including blackjack, conducted a random computer simulation to "prove" the myth that bad players cause other players' losses. He ran 100,000 simulations. He published the results on his own website. Schackler programmed his software to, what were then, standard Las Vegas Strip

round, which was a 10 playing them 14. The next card the drew was a seven for 21, which beat the table. If that means on that hand would have stood on 14, he like he was supposed to, the dealer would have gotten the picture card and busted, and we would have all been winners."

Unfortunately, most casino players have "selective memory." They'll remember losing one (or more) hands as the result of another player's misplaying his or her hand. Moreover, some players will believe the third-base player for making a bunched-up play.

However, suppose the two cards in the base were reversed; namely, the third-base player took a hit and recovered the 7 for 21, the dealer would have received the picture card and busted.

Would any of the players for the 21 and the dealer would have recovered the 7 for 21 by hitting his 14? I doubt it. This is what I mean by selective memory: You remember the "bad beats" that sometimes occur when you play blackjack, and you want to blame someone else for your losses. However, the fact is this: Every time a player misplays his hand, 5% of the time it could "hurt" other players and 50% it could "help" them. In the end, it's a wash, meaning statistically bad players do not change the odds or the house edge against a basic strategy player.

The dealer subsequently flipped over their
