

Cheesecake Redux

I was reading the *Bingo Bugle* some years ago and came across the Italian Cheesecake recipe, made it—loved it, but have since misplaced it. Can you run it again for me, please?!

Dear Janet.

½ lemon

Here's a reprint of the recipe. Enjoy again! —Annie

ITALIAN CHEESECAKE

- 1 pound ricotta cheese
- 1 ½ cups granulated sugar
- 4 eggs (beaten)
- 3 tablespoons flour

1 teaspoon vanilla

- 3 tablespoons corn starch
- 1/4 pound melted butter
- 1 pound sour cream
- 2 cups fresh fruit (blueberries, strawberries, cranberries, etc)

Non-stick cooking spray

Preheat the oven at 325 degrees. Using a large bowl, combine the ricotta cheese, cream cheese and sugar. Mix well with an electric beater. Add the eggs and mix. Juice the lemon half. Add the lemon juice, vanilla, flour, corn starch, butter and cream to the mixture. Mix well together. Spray a spring form pan (at least 9- to 10-inches wide) with non-stick cooking spray. Bake for one hour. Then turn off the oven and leave the cheesecake in the oven for two more hours. Remove and serve or refrigerate for later use. Garnish each piece with fresh fruit. Serves 10 to 12 people.

Playing Poker Out of Position is Difficult

in poker tournament that demonstrates a spade on the river. If someone bets the tricky situation that many players approach turn, I can only check-call, again having to incorrectly

Early on Day 2 with blinds at position is difficult! 1,500/3,000 with a 3,000 big blind ante, a somewhat tight, aggressive kid raised to not a good idea because it will frequently 7,000 from second position. The player in fourth position and the button called, and I decided to call 4,000 more out of my 125,000-effective stack from the big blind with the 9s6s9. While it certainly was not a great hand, calling from the big blind with suited gappers when getting amazing pot odds is usually a good idea. If you fold too often from the big blind, you will be easily exploited by your aggressive opponents.

The flop came Qc7s2s giving me a flush draw. I checked because I will have no leading range on this board that should be good for the initial raiser. The initial the button called. At this point, I thought

players, even on this somewhat dry board. I assumed the button would call with most of his one-pair hands as well as his flush draws. I had 118,000 left in my stack. So, what should I do?

Folding is out of the question unless both opponents are thought to be extremely tight because, even though I could be crushed by a better flush draw, most of the time my draw will be live.

When you have a draw and are getting decent immediate pot odds, calling is rarely a mistake. If I was facing a larger bet, perhaps 26,000 into the 32,500 pot, calling would become a worse option. The main problem with calling is that if I hit my draw on the turn, I will have a difficult time extracting value because I am out of position and I will not have the nuts. Notice that if I improve to a flush and lead into my opponents and face a raise, my flush will shrivel into a bluff catcher. If I check and I recently played a hand in a \$3,500 buy- it checks through, I have to dodge another dodge a spade. Playing draws from out of

> Raising small, perhaps to 44,000, is induce my opponents to call, which may induce them to call my small turn all-in shove with an overly wide range. When you have a junky draw and decide to play it aggressively, you want to ensure you can make your opponent's fold.

Going all in seems like a reasonable option, especially if I can make my opponents fold marginal top pairs and better flush draws. Going all in to some extent ensures that most of the time when I get called my outs will be live.

After some thought, I decided that going all in would lead to the best result for raiser bet 18,000 into the 32,500 pot. Only me. After discussing this situation with a few of my friends, I now think calling the flop bet is ideal, mainly because I am getting decent pot odds to see one more card and it decreases the odds I go broke. Minimizing the odds you go broke is a skill you must master if you want to succeed at poker tournaments. Although I gave myself **Dear Annie**, the best chance to win this specific pot, I also opened the door to go broke, which lead to disaster this time.

Tapping Underutilized Burial Benefits for Veterans

Dear Savvy Senior,

What types of funeral benefits are available to old veterans? My 83-year-old father, who has Alzheimer's disease, served during the Vietnam War in the 1960s. —Planning Ahead

Dear Planning,

National Cemetery Administration actually offers a variety of underutilized burial benefits to veterans as well as their spouses and dependents.

Most U.S. veterans (both combat and noncombat) who didn't receive a dishonorable discharge are eligible for burial benefits. To verify your dad's discharge, you'll need a copy of his DD Form 214 "Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty." If you don't have it, you can request online at Archives.gov/veterans.

Here's a rundown of some of the different benefits that are available to veterans that die a nonservice related death.

Military Cemetery Benefits

If your dad's eligible and would like to be buried in one of the 155 national or 119 state, territory or tribal-operated cemeteries (see VA.gov/find-locations), the VA provides a number of benefits at no cost to the family, including: a gravesite; opening and closing of the grave and perpetual gravesite care; a government headstone or marker; a United States burial flag that can be used to drape the casket or accompany the urn; and a Presidential Memorial Certificate

If your dad is cremated, his remains will be buried or inurned in the same manner as

But be aware that funeral or cremation arrangements and costs are not taken care of by the VA. They are the responsibility of the veteran's family, but some veteran's survivors may be eligible for burial allowances.

The VA also offers a memorial web page called the Veterans Legacy Memorial for any veteran buried in a national, state, territorial or tribal cemetery. This allows families to post pictures and stories of their loved one online as a way to remember and honor their service.

If you're interested in this option, the VA has a pre-need burial eligibility determination program to help you plan ahead before your dad passes. See VA.gov/burials-memorials/ pre-need-eligibility or call the National Cemetery Scheduling Office at 800-535-

Private Cemetery Benefits

The VA also provides benefits to veterans buried in private cemeteries. If your dad chooses this option, the VA benefits include Department of Veterans Affairs' (VA) a free government headstone or grave marker, or a medallion that can be affixed to an existing privately purchased headstone or marker; a burial flag; and a Presidential Memorial Certificate.

Funeral or cremation arrangements and costs are again the responsibility of the family, and there are no benefits offered to spouses and dependents that are buried in private cemeteries.

Military Funeral Honors

Another popular benefit available to all eligible veterans buried in either a national or private cemetery is a military funeral honors ceremony. This includes an honor guard detail of at least two uniformed military persons, folding and presenting the U.S. burial flag to the veteran's survivors, and the playing of Taps.

The funeral provider you choose will be able to assist you with all VA burial requests. Depending on what you want, certain forms may need to be completed which are always better to be done in advance.

For a complete rundown of burial and memorial benefits, eligibility details and required forms visit Cem.va.gov.

Burial Allowances In addition to the burial benefits, some

veteran's survivors may also qualify for a \$948 burial allowance and \$948 for a plot to those who choose to be buried in a private cemetery. And \$231 for a headstone or grave marker allowance. To find out if your dad is eligible or to apply, see VA.gov/burialsmemorials/veterans-burial-allowance.

DEAR PAWS: My little dog Barnsey is quite a barker for a terrier, but for the past several days his bark has been very hoarse. He sometimes snorts or sneezes, too. I make sure he has plenty of water, but I'm not sure what else to do. It doesn't seem to be getting better. — Faye H., Hartford

DEAR FAYE: This is a perfect time to take Barnsey to the vet. Chronic hoarseness when barking can have several different causes, and the veterinarian can better evaluate him to see what's happening.

I'll go over some of the reasons for a barker suddenly getting hoarse. Laryngitis is a common diagnosis, but it's important to figure out the cause. A bacterial or viral infection may be the culprit, or gastroesophageal reflux.

Less common causes are masses or tumors growing on or near the dog's larynx, or other conditions affecting the larynx. These may require surgery, and the vet will discuss this option with you.

The vet will evaluate Barnsey to see if he has an infection, acid reflux, or if the hoarse barking has another cause. They'll then be able to recommend an effective treatment. For example, a bacterial infection would likely be treated with antibiotics. A viral infection has to run its course, but Barnsey would be treated with medications to make him comfortable and reduce inflammation.

If acid reflux is the suspected culprit, the vet may recommend changes to his feeding schedule and the amount of food at each meal. You can also try different varieties of

HOLLYWOOD by Tony Pizzo **HOLLYWOOD** — om Cruise's *Mission*: Impossible 8, which has been shot so far in England, Malta, South Africa, Norway and Italy, resumed shooting in February after the strikes were settled. It's no longer called Dead Reckoning Part Two and will have a new title when it opens in May 2025.

Cruise's next project will be directed by four-time Oscar winner Alejandro G. Iñárritu, who won for directing Birdman (2014) and The Revenant (2015). The title and the script, written by Iñárritu and his Birdman co-writers, is an original story created by the 60-year-old director, who excels as a filmmaker despite having attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder.

The film is Cruise's first in his partnership with Warners, his new studio. However, he plans to keep making Mission: Impossible films, which will reconnect him to Paramount.

Speaking of Paramount, they're taking a different direction with the Transformers franchise. The live-action franchise began with Transformers (2007), starring Shia LaBeouf, and cost \$200 million while grossing \$710 million. Dark of the Moon (2011), also starring LaBeouf, cost \$195 million and grossed \$1.124 billion. Mark Wahlberg starred in Age of Extinction in 2014 (\$210 million cost with a \$1.104 billion gross) and The Last Knight in 2017 (\$260 million cost with only a \$605.4 million gross).

Then in 2018, John Cena and Hailee Steinfeld starred in Bumblebee, which cost \$135 million and only grossed \$468 million. In 2023, Anthony Ramos starred in Rise of the Beasts (a \$200 million cost, but a disappointing \$439 million gross). Small Punishments for Scammers

What always stands out, at least to me, are the low penalties for the criminals who steal from veterans and the Department of Veterans Affairs. The number of scams seems to grow, and one wonders if it's because thieves don't perceive there to be much punishment if they should be caught.

An example: A veteran threatened to blow up a VA medical facility. He verbally told the crisis line and even identified the person he specifically wanted to kill and when. He was found and arrested for making threats and even made additional threats after the arrest. Now, he hasn't gone to court yet, but the evidence is pretty strong. Why, one wonders, would he only be in line for five short years in the slammer? Yes, there could be a hefty fine, but it's the time behind bars that would keep society safe.

Another example: There was the VA employee who stole prescription drugs that were mailed to VA patients. He knew where they were going, of course, since the drugs were shipped from the VA pharmacy and he therefore had the addresses. He and his pals would break into the mailboxes to steal the drugs, which he would sell for big profits. I think about cancer patients when I learn of something like this, cancer patients who need their drugs on time, not to mention the likely pain medications. The main thief in this scam only received a sentence of 42 months in prison; his scammer pals got sentences of 12 and 35 months. Not long enough, not nearly long enough.

Then there was the guy who convinced everyone that he was blind and therefore 100% disabled and needed some benefits. Turned out he had both a drivers license and a gun carry permit and could see well enough for those activities. Not so blind after all, but his punishment was a few years of probation and some cash restitution.

So where is the deterrence to thieves and scammers when the punishment is so light?
