## Lucky Lotto News

### \$1.3 billion Mega Millions Jackpot!

After decades of waiting, two people finally claimed the \$1.34 billion Mega Millions jackpot this past September, the third largest in U.S. history, the winners Lottery announced. The two winners are a partnership, having agreed to split the prize before the winning ticket was purchased at a Speedway gas station outside Chicago. They wish to remain anonymous, only to say that they were "on the moon" about winning the jackpot, lottery officials say. The winners have been working with legal and financial advisors to support the claim process. They opted to take a reduced lump sum payment at its "current market value" of \$799.5 million, rather than receiving the full "advertised" amount of \$1.34 billion over 29 years. After taxes, the total payout comes to about \$453 million between the two winners, or \$226 million each. The odds of winning the Mega Millions jackpot 1 in 302.5 million, according to MegaMillions.com.

### U.K. EuroMillions Winner

A ticket holder came forward this past September to claim a £171m jackpot in a EuroMillions draw. Their win makes them the UK's third biggest lottery winner of all time and instantly richer than the singer Harry Styles, who is worth an estimated £100m. And, worth an estimated £150m. This is the 500 Nineteen Network of Casinos. The EuroMillions has been in the UK since 2004. The biggest win was £195m in July. In May, a Gloucestershire couple and Jon Thorne, won £184m on the EuroMillions. The EuroMillions draw is held twice a week, on Tuesdays and Fridays, and is played in nine European countries. Previously, only 15 UK players had won a jackpot of more than £100m.

### Decades Old Numbers Pay Off

George Morano of Massachusetts played the same lottery numbers for the last 50 years, and neither has he finally paid off. Morano, a Quincy resident, won \$600,000 after playing those same numbers on six "Mass Cash" tickets bought at a Super Petrolina in the city, a spokesperson for the Massachusetts State Lottery said. He won an additional \$100,000 through the same numbers on his "Mass Cash" second ticket. The lottery added, winning \$700,000 overall. Players sometimes buy several tickets and play the same numbers, the lottery said. That is often the case with "Mass Cash," which offers the best odds of winning \$100,000 of any of their games, according to the lottery.

### Dad Plays to Help Local Schools

The Idaho Lottery announced in a September press release that Bryan Moss had claimed the first \$250,000 jackpot on the Idaho Lottery Scratch Game \$250,000 Crossword. The exciting moment marked the sixth time that Moss had won a large prize from the state lottery, though this most recent win was his largest and the first time he's ever won a top prize, the release stated. "This is a remarkable run of good luck for Mr. Moss," David Weikman, the Idaho Lottery spokesman is quoted as saying. "While he has had success winning, he also truly understands that playing wisely benefits our local businesses as well as Idaho public schools and buildings." Between 1999 and 2019, the lottery has given over \$963.3 million in total dividends, the website stated. "I'm proud to help support Idaho public schools," Moss said in a statement. "That's really why I play." With his new \$250,000 jackpot win, Moss told lottery officials he plans to use the money to pay for his daughter's future education.

A reader recently asked about the biggest Bingo halls in the U.S. Here's a list of some of the larger Bingo venues from coast to coast:

- **Forewoods Resort Casino**  
This New England casino located in Marlborough, Connecticut, boasts a mammoth and stylish bingo hall with all of the amenities. Along with having a casino with a world record number of slot machines (recent count: 7,200), so many as 4,000 players at a time can enjoy the comfort and relaxing atmosphere of this bingo hall. High stakes jackpots can include top prizes over \$100,000.
- **San Manuel Indian Bingo & Casino**  
This casino, located in Highland, California on the San Manuel Indian reservation offers big prizes for players and can seat up to 2,500 players. Some of their popular promotions include their Late Game Jackpot with a \$10,000 cash prize and their Do-It-Yourself! Jackpot that can go as high as \$50,000.
- **Isleta Casino & Resort**  
Located in Albuquerque, New Mexico, the Isleta Casino and Resort features an adults-only bingo hall that can seat up to 2,500 guests. There are multiple bingo sessions with high stakes cash prizes.
- **Cherokee Trail Bingo**  
The Eastern Band Cherokee have a world class bingo operation located in the heart of the Smoky Mountains in Cherokee, North Carolina. The Cherokee bingo hall can seat up to 2,000 and regularly offers top cash prizes. This venue is very popular with tourists from all over the world.

- **Penobscot High Stakes Bingo**  
Located in Indian Island, Maine, Penobscot High Stakes Bingo is a part of the 500 Nineteen Network of Casinos. The Penobscot Nation has a fully featured casino with more than 1,000 bingo players.
- **Fort McDowell Casino**  
Located in Fort McDowell, Arizona, this casino which can seat up to 1,700 hosts more than 30,000 bingo games each year. The casino pays out \$14,000,000 annually.
- **Turning Stone Resort & Casino**  
In Verona, N.Y. up to 1,400 players can play at the Oneida Indian High Stakes Bingo Hall. This venue has often landed in the top ten of *Bingo Manager Magazine's* Top 10 Bingo Halls in North America.
- **Potawatomi Bingo Casino**  
This casino located in Milwaukee, Wisconsin can accommodate up to just over 1,500 bingo players. Progressive jackpots can reach over \$15,000 in prizes.
- **Sycuan Casino & Resort**  
Established in 1983, this very popular casino and resort located in El Cajon, California can host more than 1,000 bingo enthusiasts at once. There are multiple daily sessions with prizes each month, some of which include \$100,000 blackjack prizes, as well as evening sessions with low buy-in. Some sessions who come to Sycuan Casino qualify for discounts.
- **Owensboro Bingo**  
This bingo hall is in Green Bay, Wisconsin with over 700 bingo players at once. This venue has a variety of prizes including moving, high stakes bingo with plenty of excitement each night. Players get a chance to win a super jackpot that is worth up to \$250,000.

### This Easy Recipe Will Make You Mental For Lentils

We must congratulate the humble lentil. They have officially moved beyond soup and have been made into pasta, bread, chips and other snack foods, even plant-based meat replacements.

For home cooks, there are multitudes of reasons to love lentils. They're versatile, healthy, economical and very easy to prepare. They pack a wallop of iron, fiber, nutrition and are one of the easiest legumes to digest.

It's no wonder we're going mental for lentils!

As the world's oldest cultivated legume, this superfood comes in colors that range from green and brown to red, orange and yellow. Additionally, 1 cup of cooked lentils contains 18 grams protein, 16 grams fiber, 38 grams calcium, 64 milligrams of iron, plus magnesium, polyphenols and folate. All that for only 230 calories!

The best part? Unlike most legumes, lentils don't require soaking before cooking. They cook in about 20 minutes, making them perfect for busy weekday meals.

With their mild flavor and chewy texture, you can use them to replace or stretch the meat in your favorite recipes, like burgers, soups and casseroles. One cup of uncooked lentils becomes roughly 2 cups when cooked. You can substitute 2 cups of cooked lentils for 1 pound of hamburger, or course it depends on the recipe and other ingredients. Here is a recipe your whole family will love. Grab a fork and a bunch of napkins, because we're getting delightfully sloppy!

Introducing Sweet and Spicy Lentil Sloppy Joes. While these sandwiches are crave-worthy, it's the toppings that take this over-the-top. I highly recommend copious amounts of bread and butter pickles and onion rings.

Should you choose, you could make this recipe with 2 pounds of ground beef, omitting the lentils. Or you could halve the lentils and add 1 pound of ground beef for a blend. You also could add more veggies, like chopped carrot, mushroom and celery. This is a wonderful vehicle for adding veggies.

**SWEET AND SPICY LENTIL  
SLOPPY JOES**  
Total Time: 40 minutes  
Servings: 6-8

- 1 1/2 cups lentils, the common brown variety
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt, divided
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 package (16 ounces) frozen onion and pepper (frozen, thawed)
- 2 cloves of garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons onion powder
- 1 teaspoon smoked paprika
- 3 tablespoons tomato paste
- 2 cups (16 ounces) tomato sauce
- 2 tablespoons pickle juice
- 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
- 2 tablespoons yellow mustard
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar

Serving suggestions: hamburger buns, bread and butter pickles, onion rings, pickled jalapeños, mustard, and coleslaw

Into a small saucepan over medium-high heat, place 4 cups water, the lentils, and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to low. Simmer 20 to 22 minutes, or until tender. Drain and set aside.

If you're serving this meal with onion rings, put them in the oven according to package directions now.

While the lentils are cooking, into a large skillet on medium heat, heat the oil then add the onion and pepper, blend and cook with 1/4 teaspoon salt, stirring until they are softened. Add the garlic, chili powder, paprika and 1/2 teaspoon salt, stirring well to coat the veggies. Add the tomato paste and stir well. Next, add the tomato sauce, pickle juice, Worcestershire, mustard, and brown sugar. Stir well to incorporate. Add the cooked lentils and stir again, cooking on low for 5-10 minutes to warm through and to thicken. Serve on buns with condiments.

Lastly, this recipe is perfect for meal prepping. You can store the sloppy joe mixture in the fridge for up to seven days or freeze for six months.

Robin is a very attractive young woman who showed up one day and caught the eye of all the men in the hall. She did not appear to be flirting and was attentive to her cards. The next time I saw her, however, she sat with Larry, who up to that time had always been by himself. It was hard to tell if she was his date, or not.

The next time I saw them, they were definitely together, and he was making decisions for her about what games to play and how many cards to buy. She seemed too independent for that treatment, but what do I know? They are both lucky players and tend to win frequently. Robin did not win that day. They were together again the next week, but I suspect neither is in paradise. Robin did not look happy. Larry was his usual take charge self.

Then Robin showed up with Tim, a young man she works with. Larry arrived by himself, sat nearby and glared. Robin seemed unaffected by his presence, laughed and enjoyed herself. The couple became the center of a group of spirited young people. Larry scowled and seemed determined to make a big win to show how unaffected he was by Robin's behavior. He bought ten special cards and was hard put to keep track of all the numbers. He worked to keep up while Robin laughed and daubed her one card.

I won the game and I was a little worried but Larry would not be so seemed to be so determined, but he congratulated me through clenched teeth. "Guess I'm just unlucky tonight."



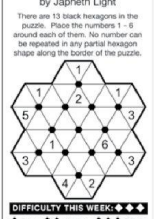

## Flu Vaccines

### Recommendations

#### Dear Savvy Senior:

I just turned 65 and would like to learn more about the stronger flu shots I've advertised for older adults. What you tell me about them and how are they covered by Medicare?  
—Senior Novice

Dear Novice,

There are actually three different types of senior-specific flu shots (you may need only) that the CDC is now recommending to people age 65 and older. These FDA-approved annual vaccines are designed to offer extra protection beyond what a standard flu provides, which is important for older adults who have weaker immune defenses and have a greater risk of developing dangerous flu complications. Here's more information on these three vaccines:

**Pneumonia Vaccines**  
Another important vaccination the CDC recommends to seniors, especially this time of year, are the pneumococcal vaccines for pneumonia. Annual 15 million Americans visit medical emergency departments each year because of pneumonia, and about 50,000 people die from it.

The CDC recently updated their recommendations for the pneumococcal vaccine and now recommend that everyone 65 and older who has not previously received any pneumococcal vaccine should get either PPSV23 (Pneumovax) or PCV15 (Vaxneuvac). PPSV23 is used most often and is followed by a dose of PPSV23 (Pneumovax23) at least one year later.

OR: If you've previously received a PPSV23 shot, you should get one dose of PCV15 or PCV20 at least one year later. Medicare Part B also covers two different pneumococcal shots: the first shot at any time and a different, second shot if it's at least one year after the first shot.

**COVID Booster**  
If you haven't already done so, you should also get a COVID-19 booster shot this fall. Both Moderna and Pfizer have developed two-level booster vaccines that add an Omicron BA.4/5 component to the old formula, which provides better protection.

## Slots Q&A

**Q:** Does it matter how fast or slow you play a slot machine?

**A:** The speed at which you play a slot machine has no effect on whether or how much you win or lose. The slot's computer program doesn't know or care how fast or slow you're playing. The faster you play, the faster you go through your bankroll and playing time. There's a term for ultra-fast slot playing (hitting the button the instant that reels stop spinning). It's called "steaming."

**Q:** Where can I buy a used slot machine for my den?

**A:** To buy a used version of a slot machine, look on the Internet under Slot Machines for Sale, particularly eBay. Note, however, that almost every state restricts private ownership of slot machines. You can find restrictions for your state on the Internet. Or the seller should be able to tell you about the restrictions in your state.

**Q:** Is it safe for a person with a pacemaker to play the slot machines in a casino?

**A:** Yes, it's safe to play with a pacemaker, but it may not be safe for your wallet.

**Q:** What happens to a slot machine when it no longer makes money for the casino?

**A:** The slot machines a casino orders from the manufacturer are mostly played on lease. And the lease states that if the game isn't making any money the manufacturer must replace the game with a different one. With most games, the manufacturer simply takes the old game out of the cabinet and replaces it with a new one. You'll rarely see casino personnel hauling a 100-100-pound slot machine around the casino.

## Getting to Know the Bingo Manager

I hope you are well and, because this is a month of Thanksgiving, I am going to dwell on the reasons we should give thanks when it comes to Bingo! I have been joining every month for more than twenty years in this publication. During that time, I have gotten a lot of e-mail (remember, I have a BRAND-NEW e-mail address: bingo@enr.com).

So, to the topic at hand. Over the years, I have heard a lot of complaints from people about their Bingo ball. Twenty years ago, the big complaints concerned TOO MUCH SMOKE in the balls. I smoke pipes, so the biggest complaints centered around folks who nuzzled. Now, the complaints are from people who find small things wrong, but don't know what to do about their complaints.

So, here is my advice to you. Find out who the manager of your ball is. And, remember, there will be a big difference if you are playing in a funny casino, a pay-for-play hall or a non-profit hall. It is important to get to know the manager BEFORE you have a problem.

In most halls, the manager has the final say, based, of course, on what the rules are for Bingo in that state. In large halls, the manager will likely have an office. At the smaller non-profits, his or her office is likely at home. But no matter where you play, remember one thing: the manager has an enormous burden to bear. State rules are complex and can change without 'roe' the line" when it comes to obeying and enforcing them to the letter. And there is a huge amount of paperwork involved. Also remember, if you have a complaint and are playing in a casino or major hall, it is likely that the manager has a couple of managers above them—so it may take a while to get things resolved.

The bottom line is that you are a PAYING CUSTOMER. You deserve a certain level of service. And, you may need to contact with the manager to determine who you can expect from them.

I should point out, though, that a major cause of the problem of MUMBLING CALLERS comes from the fact that one reason is that managers know that employees are not paid. And, if you are in a hall where you have to consult the TOTY Board to figure out what the caller said, it's time to have a chat with the manager.

So, I think that we ARE able to play Bingo. Patience the balls. And, have fun. SILENT when you win. We are not playing in a funny casino, a pay-for-play hall or a non-profit hall. It is important to get to know the manager BEFORE you have a problem.
