\$1.3 billion Mega Millions Jackpot

After weeks of waiting, two people finally claimed the \$1.34 billion Mega Millions jackpot this past September, the third largest in U.S. history, the Illinois Lottery announced. The two winners are a partnership, having agreed to split the prize before the winning ticket was purchased at a Speedway gas station outside Chicago. They wish to remain anonymous, only to say that they were "over the moon" about winning the jackpot, lottery officials say. The winners have been working with legal and financial advisors to support the claim process. They opted to take a reduced lump sum payment at its "current market value" of \$780.5 million, rather than receiving the full "advertised" amount as 30 annualized payments over 29 years. After taxes, the otal payout comes to about \$453 million between the two winners, or \$250 million each. The odds of winning the Mega Millions jackpot: 1 in 302.5 million, according to MegaMillions com

U.K. EuroMillione Winner A ticket holder came forward this past September to claim a £171m jackpot in a EuroMillions draw. Their win makes them the UK's third biggest lottery winner of all time and instantly richer than the singers Harry Styles, who is worth an estimated £100m, and Adele, worth an estimated £150m. This is the sixth EuroMillions jackpot won in the UK this year. The biggest win was £195m in July. In May, a Gloucestershire couple, Joe and Jess Thwaite, won £184m on the EuroMillions. The EuroMillions draw s held twice a week, on Tuesdays and Fridays, and is played in nine European

countries. Previously, only 15 UK players

had won a jacknot of more than £100m.

Decades Old Numbers Pay Off George Morano of Massachusetts played

the same lottery numbers for the last 30 years, and earlier this fall, it finally paid off. Morano, a Quincy resident, won \$600,000 after playing those same numbers on six "Mass Cash" tickets bought at a Super Petroleum in the city, a spokesperson for the Massachusetts State Lottery said He won an additional \$100,000 through the same numbers on his "Mass Cash season ticket, the lottery added, winning \$700,000 overall. Players sometimes buy several tickets and play the same numbers. the lottery said. That is often the case with "Mass Cash," which offers the best odds of winning \$100,000 of any of their games, according to the lottery.

Dad Plays to Help Local Schools

The Idaho Lottery announced in a September press release that Bryan Moss had claimed the first \$250,000 jackpot on the Idaho Lottery Scratch Game \$250,000 Crossword. The exciting moment marked the sixth time that Moss had won a large prize from the state lottery though this most recent win was his largest and the first time he's ever won a top prize, the release stated. "This is a remarkable run of good luck for Mr. Moss," David Workman, the Idaho Lottery spokesman is quoted as saying. "While he has had success winning, he also truly understands that playing wisely benefits our local businesses as well as Idaho public schools and buildings." Between 1990 and 2019, the lottery has given out \$961.5 million in total dividends, the website stated "I'm proud to help support Idaho public schools." Moss said in a statement. "That's really why I play." With his new \$250,000 jackpot winnings, Moss told lottery officials he plans on using the money to pay for his daughter's future education.

Lawsuit Filed against MGM Resorts A lawsuit has been filed in a federal district court in southern Mississippi that charges MGM Resorts International of intentionally shortchanging patrons by not paying out the exact amount of TITO tickets at redemption kiosks. The complainant is suing over MGM's practice of rounding down to the nearest dollar, then dispensing another ticket for the change that has to be redeemed at the casino cashier, a practice that began during the brief national coin shortage in the early days of the pandemic but was never discontinued. The crity of the lawsuit is MGM's lack of notice at the kiosk that it holds back the change: the complaint cites the Wynn as adequately informing players of their need to go to the cage to collect the remaining nickels, dimes, etc. The suit alleges breach of contract, conversion (a legal term that basically boils down to stealing) uninst enrichment and quantum meruit (restitution for uninst enrichment). This is the first salvo at an attempt to turn

U.S. Sports Betting According to a Pew Research Center study, just under one in five (19%) American adults made some kind of sports bet over the past year. Fifteen percent of respondents said they bet informally with friends or family in a private pool, fantasy league, or peer to peer. Only 8% said they'd made bets at a casino sports book/kiosk or racetrack, while 6% said they made their wagers online (not differentiating between legal and unregulated sites).

the complaint into a class-action lawsuit.





Don't Fear Video Poker

I receive many communications from slot players who want to play video poker but don't know how and don't even know where to start. Many think the games might be too tough for them to learn. This is not true. Video poker is fun and the games are relatively easy to learn.

A big problem is that many players are indeed confused by the myriad of different video poker games in different denominations that they see on the casino floor. But don't panic, video poker is actually a simple game. Following is the general scheme:

The machine will randomly deal you five cards from a 52-card virtual deck (for the moment, let's ignore Joker Poker which is dealt from a 53-card deck). You get to hold as many cards from the initial five-card hand that you wish (you could hold one card, two, all

ive, or even none of them). Once you decide which cards you want to hold, you hit the draw button and the computer will randomly deal you the appropriate replacement cards to replace the cards you discarded. That's it, game over. If those cards show that you win, that's good. If you lose? Well, then just try again!

How much you win (if anything) depends on the rank of your final fivecard noker hand

Usually, you will need at least a pair of jacks through aces to get your bet back (even money payoff). If you have two pair, you'll be paid more. Ditto for a three-of-a-kind, a flush, all the way to the highest hand, a royal flush. You must pay full coin/credits in order to get the biggest payout on the royal flush, Royal flushes are somewhat rare, but they do happen, and they do give you a big monetary boost, so play maximum coins/credits.

The pay schedule for the winning hands are posted on the video screen for each game.

O: Does it matter how fast or slow you play a slot machine?

A: The speed at which you play a slot machine has no effect on whether or how much you win or lose. The slot's computer program doesn't know or care how fast or slow you're playing. The faster you play, the faster you go through your bankroll and playing time. There's a term for ultrafast slot playing (hitting the button the instant the reels stop spinning). It's called "steaming."

Q: Where can I buy a used slot machine for my den?

A: To buy a used version of a slot machine look on the Internet under Slot Machines for Sale, particularly eBay.

Note, however, that almost every state restricts private ownership of slot machines. You can find restrictions for your state on the Internet. Or the seller should be able to tell you about the restrictions in your state.

The Money Was Going In - An Unavoidable Bad Beat Ry Chad Holloway

There are many different ways to play a hand of poker, but occasionally it doesn't matter how you play it, the result will always be the same. Some hands just contain all the right ingredients to make it a recipe for disaster.

In a recent hand that took place in a \$600 buy-in no-limit hold 'em tournament at the Wynn Las Vegas, it was Level 6 (500/1,000/1,000) when I opened for 2,200 holding the 4h-4c and the player in the cutoff called. Action folded to the big

blind, who called to make it three-way action to a flop of Kc-4d-8s.

The big blind checked, and I continued for 2,000 bottom set. Much to my delight, the cutoff moved all in for 18,000. The big blind folded and I quickly called holdin a nearly identical stack. The cutoff tabled the Ks-10s and was way behind my threeof-a-kind.

At that point, I was a huge 94.44% favorite while the cutoff had only a

No matter how he played it after the flop, he was going to win a massive pot despite being behind all the way to the river. It's just the manner in which he played it that added to the brutalness of

I should point out, though, that in major cities, the problem of MUMBLING CALLERS does continue. I think one reason is that managers know that employees are hard to find. But, if you are in a hall where you have to consult the TOTE BOARD to figure out what the caller said, it's time to have a chat with the
