U.S. Gaming Report

The American Gaming Association's published data showing the first quarter of 2022 produced the highest gaming revenues in U.S. history. The AGA said commercial gaming in January, February and March reached \$16.8 billion for casinos, sports books and legal online wagering sites. That was 15.5 percent higher than the first quarter of 2022. That information was revealed in two AGA reports. Its commercial gaming revenue market and the association's "State of the States" report, suggest of which follow.
 The Strip is by far the most successful gaming market by revenue in the country and No. 1 Atlantic City just remains close. In 2022, the Strip generated \$8.24 billion in gross gaming revenue. Next on the list was Atlantic City, which reported \$2.79 billion that year, followed by — a surprise to some — Baltimore and Washington D.C. and the casinos in Maryland and West Virginia with \$2.17 billion in gross gaming revenue.
 Among the top 10 Nevada markets in the United States, three more in Nevada made the list. The Reno Strip ranked 10th in the country with revenue of \$667 million. Reno's guests checked in on No. 12 with 991 million and Downtown Las Vegas was 17th at \$787 million.
 One of the reasons Baltimore-Washington D.C. fared so well is that the market is home to the property that had the highest gross gaming revenue outside of Nevada — MGM Resorts International's Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Harbor project, which opened in December 2016. Another recent opened by a Las Vegas-based company named 2 among those with highest 2017 revenue outside of the U.S.

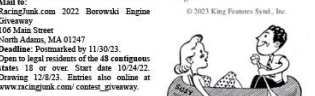

Make a Mistake in Poker? It Can Still Have a Positive Outcome

Poker is a funny game in that you can not only lose a hand but still lose the pot. It also can take a minute and get reworked for if I recently witnessed such a hand take place when a player failed to see another player's all-in bet. As a result, they swung up in a spot they otherwise wouldn't, and as fate would have it, they came out on the other end with all the chips.

The hand took place on Day 2 of the World Poker Tour (WPT) Poker Showdown \$3,500 Main Event at South Florida's Seminole Hard Rock Hollywood. The tournament attracted 2,290 entrants and offered up a \$73,230 prize pool to the top 27 finishers.

In Level 10, the blinds were 10,000/200/100/200 and 122 players remained when WPT Champion Josh Samuel James Calderone, who in 2014 posted a 41-streer fold to win the WPT Lucky Hearts Poker Award for \$27,163, moved all-in for 380,000 first to cost (aka under the gun).

It was a good example that in poker, even mistakes can result in positive outcomes.

Q: I was given a box of old perfume bottles. One had blue glass, and the label reads "Evelyn in Paris" and the other had silver. Can you tell me about this perfume and are the bottles valuable?

A: The French cosmetics company Bourjois made "Evelyn in Paris" (Evee Parly) in 1928. It was one of the most popular fragrances sold in the United States throughout World War II. The perfume was discontinued in 1969. Ernest Bourjois created the Bourjois line, and it is also known for creating "Clanad No. 5." PACT Act Benefits

A bill-outside claims have been filed under the PACT Act for exposure to Agent Orange. The act was signed in August, when the law was signed.

Three million veterans have had their new screenings since, and nearly half of them had exposure. Since last August, 215,000 veterans have signed up for Department of Veterans Affairs health care. A big increase over the previous year. And a big increase also (starting last October), the VA has paid out over \$65 billion on compensation benefits.

Under the PACT Act, any subsequent illnesses are presumptive, meaning that it's assumed that your health condition is caused by exposure to toxins if you live at one of the locations at certain times. The act also does not require prescreening to get benefits.

The list of illnesses from exposure to toxins includes: cancers of the brain, head, kidney, skin, prostate, and many more. Less serious are allergic rhinitis, bronchial asthma, and other conditions.

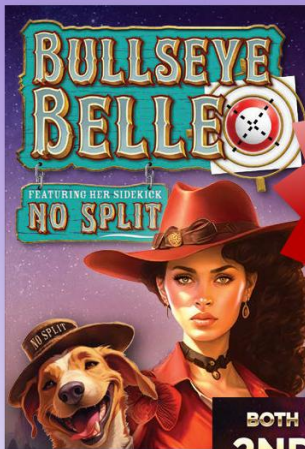

Standard Deviation Explained by Henry Tamburin

Even the most highly skilled players suffer losing streaks. It's often the culprit that causes a player's bankroll to swing wildly, so it's important that you understand a little about SD. But I promise not to bore you too much math. Instead, I'll show you how SD can be used to predict and understand the results of your playing sessions.

Bankroll SD is a measure of the variance (or difference) between an actual result compared to an expected result. For example, how many hands would you expect if you flipped a coin 100 times? You probably said 50. However, in the real world it's rare that you get exactly 50 heads or 50 tails, and you'll see that. Most likely, you'll wind up with more, or less, than 50 heads, and it's unlikely that you'll get the same result each 100 coin-flip trial.

If you want to know beforehand how far away you most likely will be from exactly 50 heads (i.e., the coin boundary) you need to calculate the SD. In the case of our 100-trial coin-flip game, the math yields an SD of 5. This means that instead of ending up with exactly 50 heads as expected, you will end up with a range of 45 to 55 heads plus or minus 5 (i.e., 5SD), or 25 heads that is a likelihood in the process. But a large number of trials, or SDs, equals 4 in 63.5% of the trials you will wind up between plus and minus one SD from the expected result. If you want to know the probability result with more accuracy, you will need to use the 2SD, or 2SD (95.45% certainty), or 3SD (99.73% certainty).

(Note: Our 100-coin-flip example is not an overly difficult question; the percent probabilities will be slightly different than the above-mentioned probabilities.)

Now here's a bet on each coin flip. At the 2SD probable outcome, you will still be somewhere between 40 and 60 heads, about 95% of the time.

If heads comes up 95 times, you would be a winner of \$20 (one ten dollar or 40 fifty cent) but lose one dollar on 40 fifty cent bets. This means you'd end up with 40 bets came up only 40 times, you'd win 40 bets and lose 40 bets. So, you'd end up with a net of zero. You would end up winning or losing between \$10 and \$30, or 40-60 cents, and the only 5% of the time would your final outcome be a win or loss outside that range.

So, what's the lesson learned in all this? First, experiencing losing sessions as a basic money player is quite normal and should be as no surprise. The reason you have to understand an expected result is because you are not alone. However, it is often the culprit that causes a player's bankroll to swing wildly, so it's important that you understand a little about SD. But I promise not to bore you too much math. Instead, I'll show you how SD can be used to predict and understand the results of your playing sessions.

Bankroll SD is a measure of the variance (or difference) between an actual result compared to an expected result. For example, how many hands would you expect if you flipped a coin 100 times? You probably said 50. However, in the real world it's rare that you get exactly 50 heads or 50 tails, and you'll see that. Most likely, you'll wind up with more, or less, than 50 heads, and it's unlikely that you'll get the same result each 100 coin-flip trial.

Decluttering — Do It Your Way

Consider this a firsthand account of cleaning clutter. I read several self-help books. I sought advice from those who call themselves experts. But I suspected that the "how to declutter" books would be a lost cause when I saw passages that suggested taking photos of cherished items as a way of remembering them. I knew that plan was not for me. It was the same with instructions to take one room at a time or to take notes on things to toss. In the end, I rejected all I held and read and opted for doing it my way quickly and ruthlessly.

The key to successful decluttering is to ask yourself essential questions:

Give yourself one month to declutter, working at it for at least an hour every day, tossing things up as you go and dividing them into items to be donated or to be thrown out. At the end of the month, call the dump haulers or the people who take donations. Keep in mind: If you haven't put up outdoor holiday decorations in a year, you won't start now. Relatives who indicate they want a certain item need to receive it immediately. You really don't need 17 sets of sheets or more than five pairs of pajamas, but her own mother's cherished items for 30 years doesn't mean you need to do the same. Best of all: If something is so long on a shelf, you don't have to dust it.

How Medicare Covers Physical Therapy Services

Dear Savvy Senior,
Does Medicare cover physical therapy, and if so, how much coverage do they provide? My 66-year-old husband was recently diagnosed with Parkinson's disease and will need ongoing physical therapy to help keep his moving.
— Howard PPK

Dear Worried,
Yes, Medicare does indeed pay for physical therapy along with occupational and speech therapy, too, if it meets, it, as long as it is prescribed by his doctor. You'll also be happy to know that Medicare has no limit on how much it will pay for therapy services, but there is an annual coverage threshold you should be aware of. Here's what you should know.

Outpatient Therapy
To get Medicare Part B — which covers outpatient care — to help cover your husband's physical therapy, it must be considered medically necessary and will be ordered by his doctor. The same holds true for occupational and speech therapy.
You can get these services at an outpatient at a number of places like a doctor or therapist office, in a hospital outpatient department, at an outpatient rehabilitation facility, at skilled nursing facilities if he is being treated as an inpatient, and at home through a therapist contracted with a home health agency when it is infeasible for Medicare's home health benefit.
For outpatient therapy, Medicare will pay 80 percent of the Medicare-approved amount after you meet your Part B deductible (2023 at \$226). You will be responsible for the remaining 20 percent unless you have supplemental insurance.
But be aware that if his therapy costs reach \$3,330 in a calendar year (2023), Medicare

Will require his provider to confirm that his therapy is still medically necessary. Medicare used to set annual limits on what it would pay for outpatient therapeutic services, but the cap was eliminated a few years back.

You also need to know that treatment recommended by a physical therapist provider but not ordered by a doctor is not covered. In this situation, the therapist is required to give your husband a written notice, called an Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage (ABN), that Medicare may not pay for the service. If he chooses to proceed with the therapy, he is agreeing to pay in full.
Approved Therapy
If your husband happens to need physical therapy at an inpatient rehabilitation facility like at a skilled nursing facility or at your home after a hospitalization lasting at least three days, Medicare Part A, which provides hospital coverage, will pick up the tab.
It will be eligible, his doctor will need to certify that he has a medical condition that requires rehabilitation, continued medical supervision, and coordinated care that comes from his doctors and therapists working together.
Whether you incur out-of-pocket costs such as deductibles and coinsurance, and how much they are, will depend on the setting for the treatment and how long it lasts. For more information on inpatient therapy out-of-pocket costs see Medicare.gov's www.Medicare.gov Medicare Advantage Coverage.
If your husband is enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan (like an HMO or PPO), these plans must cover everything that's included in original Medicare, Part A and Part B coverage. However, some Advantage plans do not cover certain services from physical therapy practices within an assigned network.
If he has an Advantage plan, you'll need to contact his specific plan before selecting a physical therapy provider to confirm you're in the network.

Casino Q&A

Q: I enjoy playing bingo, but I seldom win anything more than my \$10. I can use to improve my chances of winning?
A: Like the other casino games, bingo numbers in keno are selected at random. And for a game where the numbers are entirely random, there can be no strategy.
There are, however, a few things you should know about bingo. I can use to your advantage on a live keno game is a steep 28% hit rate. In a 20-line bingo game, you'll hit 5.6 numbers. But at a video game, you play faster, thus you also lose faster.
Helpful tip: Play six numbers. In keno, numbers have a probability to be drawn. The numbers 28, 27, 25, 15, 16, and 27 come up a little more often than others. It's a favorite strategy for regular players. But whether numbers you pick, stick with them. When you get tired of playing these numbers, play a different set of numbers. You can't win. Finally, play 9-10-w-9's. And don't forget to use your play-by-click card.

Q: Is there a strategy for beating cops?
A: No. The only way to beat the game is by learning how to control your throw of the dice. And this is a technique that requires many months of practice. To learn more about this technique, you might consider checking out Frank Scobello's book, *Golden Touch Dice Revolution: How to Win at Craps for Real* or *Control the Dice Throw*. It shows how the dice should stick in the air, land, and come back to you.

Q: In roulette, is the ton board that shows the last 20 numbers hit or any of the last 10?
A: Absolutely none. Roulette is a game of chance. And in games of chance, what happens to the past is irrelevant. What will happen in the future, 50, the numbers you bet on the table boards are meaningless.

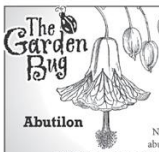

Raise the quinoa under cold running water in a fine mesh strainer for 1-2 minutes. This helps remove any bitterness from the quinoa. In a medium saucepan, combine the quinoa and water or broth. Add a pinch of salt, if desired.

Bring the mixture to a boil, reduce the heat to low and cover with a lid. Simmer for 15 minutes. Remove the sea-greens from the heat and let the quinoa sit, covered, for 10 more minutes.

Fluff the quinoa with a fork and serve.

The easiest way to cook other grains? Boil them like pasta. (I'm a rebel, I know.) Summer the grains in a good amount of well-salted water, periodically stirring as they cook until they are the right texture, sit alone. Then drain them in a fine-mesh strainer.
