U.S. Gaming Report

The American Gaming Association recently published data showing the first quarter of 2023 produced the highest gaming recome of any morter in industry history. The AGA said commercial gaming nary, February and March reached \$16.6 billion for casinos, sports books and legal online wagering sites. That was 15.5 percent higher than the first quarter of 2022. That information was revealed in two AGA reports, its commercial gaming revenue tracker and the association's "State of the

States" report, snippets of which follow: The Strip is by far the most successful New York next year. Chicago's new casino to be operated by Bally's Corp., is due to raming market by revenue in the country and No. 2 Atlantic City isn't anywhere close. In 2022, the Strip generated \$8.24 billion in Sports wagering has continued to grow nationwide, and New York is the undisputed Atlantic City, which reported \$2.79 billion king of sports bets thanks to its approval of

Make a Mistake in Poker? It Can Still Have

a Positive Outcome By Chad Holloway

Poker is a funny game in that you can not only play your best and still lose, but you also can make a mistake and get rewarded for it. I recently witnessed such a hand take place where a player failed to see another player's all-in shove. As a result, they wound up in a snot they otherwise wouldn't and as fate would have it, they came out the other end with all the chips.

The hand took place on Day 2 of the World Poker Tour (WPT) Poker Showdown \$3,500 Main Event at South Florida's Seminole Hard Rock Hollywood. The tournament attracted 2.290 entrants and offered up a \$7,328,000 prize pool to the

In Level 20, the blinds were 10.000/20.000/20.000 and 122 players

remained when WPT Champions Club member James Calderaro, who in 2014 topped a 415-entry field to win the WPT Lucky Hearts Poker Open for \$271.103. moved all-in for 380,000 first to act (aka under the gun).

Natasha Mercier, the wife of future Poker Hall of Famer Jason Mercier and an extremely accomplished player in her own right, didn't see that Calderaro had shoved and she mit out 45 000 thinking she was open-raising. Per the rules, she had two options at that point: fold and sacrifice the 45,000 she committed accidentally, or call the all-in warer

She used a time extension to contemplate the decision and ultimately called. The action then folded around to Marc Spungin in the big blind and he moved all-in over the top for approximately 500,000. It was an "in for a penny, in for a pound" situation for Mercier, who needed to call only 120,000

more, which she did. Spungin had the best hand with the 10c-10s, Calderaro was next up with the 9c-9d, and Mercier held two overs with her Kc-Qc. As it stood, Spungin was a slight 43.31% favorite. Mercier had a 38,33% chance of winning and Calderaro would come from

behind just 18% of the time. It wasn't a bad spot for Mercier given she had accidentally found herself in a threeway all-in. Had she noticed Calderaro's initial jam, there's a strong likelihood shwould've folded preflop as king-queen, even suited isn't a great hand for which to call from either early or middle position. It got even better for Mercier when the

floo fell Ks-7s-3h to pair her king and make her a heavy 78.07% favorite. Neither the 7c turn nor 6s river changed a thing and Mercies scored the double knockout. Because he had the shorter stack in the hand. Calderard officially finished in 122nd place while Marc Spungin took 121st, though both paid \$8 250 It was a good example that in poker, even @ 2023 King Features Synd., Inc.

The cobalt blue bottles of "Evening in Paris" are collectibles. A set of four empty bottles like yours recently sold for \$59.

PACT Act Benefits

A half-million claims have been filed under the PACT Act for exposure to toxins. So far, over \$1 billion has been paid in benefits. And that's just since last August, when the act

Three million veterans have had their new the dashboard at www.accesstocare.va.gov screenings since then, and nearly half of them healthcare/nactact. Info is undated there had exposures. Since last August, 215,000 veterans have signed up for Department of Veterans Affairs health care, a big increase over the previous year. And this fiscal year alone (starting last October), the VA has paid out over \$65 billion on compensation

With the PACT Act, any subsequent illnesses are presumptive, meaning that it's assumed that your health condition is caused by exposure to toxins if you were in certain locations at certain times. The act adds over 20 new presumptives to the list.

The list of illnesses from exposure to toxins are serious: cancers of the brain, head, kidney, neck, pancreas and many more, Less serious are allergic rhinitis, bronchial asthma, chronic bronchitis and others. Of the @ 2023 King Features Synd., Inc

five conditions most frequently claimed via the PACT Act, hypertensive vascular disease

tops the list, with 80% of claims granted.

To read more about the PACT Act, go to every other Friday. A recent issue of the dashboard says that wrapping up PACT claims is taking an average of 156 days. At that time, 45.6% of claims were at over 125 days of being completed, and the approval rate was 80%. Be sure to scroll down the

page as there is a lot of info itionally, you can check va.gov/pact or call them at 800-MVV/A411 Note: The VA wants us to sign up for

PACT benefits. If we do this before Aug. 10, 2023, the benefits will likely be backdated a year, to Aug. 10, 2022. Mark that date on your calendar and don't let it slip by if you intend to file for PACT benefits. In fact, why don't you get started now?

Standard Deviation

Explained

Even the most highly skilled players suffer losing streaks (been there, done that). Sometimes the reason has nothing to do with not knowing basic strategy, or the "bad play" of your fellow players, or a "cheating

No, the reason is due to aticians call standard deviation (which I will refer to as SD). If you've never heard of SD, don't free, because you are not alone. However, it is often the culprit that causes a player's bankroll to swing wildly, so it's important that you understand a little about SD. But

I promise not to bore you too much math. Instead, I'll show you how SD can be used to predict and understand the results of your playing sessions. Basically, SD is a measure of the variance

(or difference) between an actual result commence) oetween an actual result compared to an expected result. For example, how many heads would you expect if you flipped a coin 100 times? You probably said 50. However, in the real world it's rare that your outcome would be exactly 50 heads (try it, and you'll see). Most likely, you'll wind up with more, or less, than 50 heads, and it's unlikely that you'll get the each 100-coin-flip trial.

If you want to know beforehand how far away you most likely will be from exactly 50 heads (i.e., the outer boundary) you need to calculate the SD. In the case of our Lotto Winner Invests Wisels 100-trial coin-flip game, the math yields an SD of 5. This means that instead of ending up with exactly 50 heads as expected, you will probably end up in the range of 50 plus or minus 5 (1 SD), or between 45 and prus or minus 3 (1 5D), or between 43 and 55 heads. How probable is probable? For a large number of trials, one 5D implies that in 68.3% of the trials you will wind up between plus and minus one SD from the expected he'd turned that fortune into \$1 billion through a series of shrewd investments and not making large and lavish purchases. result. The point is that by calculating the SD you can predict how much money you should expect to be shead or behind in this 100-trial

coin-flip game with a fair degree of certainty. What happens if you were to wind up losing \$40 after 100-coin flips? I'd look carefully at the coin, because it is highly unlikely that you would be that far outside the 2SD lower boundary of -\$20 if the game were fair.

So, what's the lesson learned in all this? First, experiencing losing sessions as a basic strategy player is quite normal and should come as no surprise. The reason you have some winning and some losing sessions is due to the natural fluctuations of the name (i.e., SD). Secondly, in the short term you could experience many consecutive winning or losing sessions, because luck has a lot to do with your outcome. Thirdly, the longer you play, the more likely your final outcome will favor will ultimately prevail over "luck

How Medicare Covers Physical **Therapy Services**

Dear Savvy Senior Does Medicare cover physical therapy,

and if so, how much coverage do they provide? My 66-year-old husband was recently diagnosed with Parkinson's disease and will need ongoing physical therapy to

Yes, Medicare does indeed pay for physical therapy along with occupational and speech therapy too, if he needs it, as long as it's prescribed by his doctor. You'll also be happy to know that Medicare has no limits on how much it will pay for therapy services, but there is an annual coverage threshold you should be aware of. Here's what you should Outpatient Therapy

To get Medicare Part B - which covers outpatient care - to help cover your husband's physical therapy, it must be considered medically necessary and will need to be ordered by his doctor. The same holds true for occupational and speech therapy.

He can get these services as an outpatient a a number of places like a doctor or therapist office; in a hospital outpatient department; at an outpatient rehabilitation facility: at skilled nursing facilities if he is being treated as an outpatient; and at home through a therapist connected with a home health agency when he is inclimble for Medicare's home health

For outpatient therapy, Medicare will pay 80 percent of the Medicare-approved amount after you meet your Part B deductible (\$226 in 2023). You will be responsible for the remaining 20 percent unless you have

But be aware that if his therapy costs reach \$2,230 in a calendar year (2023), Medicare

recommended by a physical therapy provider but not ordered by a doctor is not covered. In this situation, the therapist is required to give your husband a written notice, called an Advance Beneficiary Notice of Noncoverage or ABN, that Medicare may not pay for the service. If he chooses to proceed with the therapy, he is agreeing to pay in full. Inpatient Therapy

If your husband happens to need physical therapy at an inpatient rehabilitation facility like at a skilled nursing facility or at your home after a hospitalization lasting at least three days, Medicare Part A - which provides hospital coverage - will pick up the tab.

To be eligible, his doctor will need to certify that he has a medical condition that requires rehabilitation, continued medical supervision, and coordinated care that comes from his doctors and therapists working

Whether you incur out-of-pocket costs such as deductibles and coinsurance, and how much they are, will depend on the setting for the treatment and how long it lasts. For more information on inpatient Dear Fred. therapy out-of-pocket costs see Medicare.
