We're going to explore infusing vodka Undoubtedly, you've seen flavored

vodkas on liquor store shelves, but have you ever thought of making your own infused vodka? Not only is it very inexpensive, but say goodbye to artificial flavorings and colors and hello to absolute control over the ingredients.

It's surprisingly easy to do. All you need is a large, wide-mouth glass jar with an airtight lid (not plastic, unless you're making plastic-flavored vodka!), a fine mesh strainer, cheese cloth or coffee filters. and a funnel. Save empty vodka bottles to refill with your infused creations later. Of course, you'll need vodka and ingredients to infuse, but we'll get to that in a moment

First, I'd like to share how to make cheap vodka taste more like top shelf vodka. There is no sense in paying for top shelf vodka for our purpose. The secret is filtering vodka with a charcoalactivated water filter, like a Brita or PUR brand filter pitcher. Just designate a new filter exclusively for vodka, because you won't want to use it for water after you use it for vodka. Activate the new filter, as per manufacturer instructions, then drain



find seven times is the charm Will this method fool a sophisticated palate into thinking it's top shelf? Nope. Will it improve the results when infused or

mixed in a cocktail? Absolutely How to Infuse Vodka - Into a clean glass jar with a lid, place your infusion

ingredients, top off with vodka and close lid. Shaking the jar daily, infuse for 12 hours to 7 days. Different ingredients require different amounts of time to infuse, and then there's adjustment to your personal taste

I have guidelines below, but taste your infusion every day until you're satisfied with your results. It's a tough job, but somebody's got to do it.

When you're happy with the flavor, strain the infusion material out and decant into a clean bottle or iar. Enjoy immediately or store in a cool, dark place for up to 12

OHESTIONS

ANSWERS

(1) FALSE, Blackjack games that specify alers must hit all 17s, including a soft 17, give the house an extra 0.2% edge over the player (compared to standing on soft 17). This rule favors the house, not the player

(2) FALSE. Even though getting the guaranteed 1 to 1 (even money) payoff seems like a good idea, in the long run you'll average more (roughly a 1.04 to 1 ayout) if you decline taking even money. (3) SEVEN. Don't even think about saying it. The reason? Most craps players believe that this unmentionable number causes right bettors to lose on point rolls. Players generally refer to "it" as "Big Red." (4) DEALER MUST HAVE ACE-KING or

HIGHER. This rule also frustrates most players because if the dealer doesn't qualify, a player does not win a bonus payoff regardless of how good a hand he (5) TRUE. No matter if it's Matchplay.

bonus blackjack, or a free ace coupon, you will have the best of it whenever you (6) FALSE. It's possible to get returns over 100% by playing video poker skillfully.

76% of your hands. You'll make up for most, but not all, of your losses on the 24% of the hands that you win because about 8% pay more than even money. However, overall the house keeps more than players win and maintains a healthy 3.5% advantage. (9) IOIN THE SLOT CLUB. You can't earn

points for your slot (or video poker) play unless you join the casino's slot club and insert the card into the machine's card reader when you play. (10) EALSE Roulette chine cannot be

converted to cash at the cashier so don't leave the table with them. You can cothem to casino chins at the roulette table where you are playing.

Americans Bet Big on Soccer

GeoComply, the geolocation, compliance, and anti-fraud company for online sports books, reports that the World Cup Final was "the second most wagered-on sporting event of 2022." Only the Super Bowl recorded more geolocated transactions for a single event. Upwards of 7.9 million individual bets were made on the Final at U.S. sports books, well more than on the NBA Finals (5.1 million), March Madness Finals (4.8 million), and the NHL Stanley Cup Final (1.9 million). The 1.7 million unique user accounts from which wagers were placed on the World Cup Final were also second only to the Super Bowl's 3.1 million.

Waldorf Astoria at Crystal Bay

Hilton has announced that its Waldorf Astoria brand will replace the vintage Tahoe Biltmore in Crystal Bay on the north shore of Lake Tahoe. The 76-yearold Biltmore closed last April and is scheduled to be demolished in the spring. The Waldorf Astoria will be built on the 15-acre property, with 76 guest rooms and 61 branded residences. It will feature an "upscale" casino, according to the announcement as well as several food and beverage outlets, including a poolside restaurant and a lounge, Peacock Alley, named for the one at the original Waldorf Astoria in New York City. There will also be a "community grove" with shopping and more restaurants, a spa and fitness facility, and access to a three-acre lakefront beach club. The property is expected to open sometime in 2027.

Big Blackjack Win in AZ

A 21-year-old Phoenix resident hit a jackpot worth \$1,100,075 while playing blackjack at Gila River Lone Butte in Chandler. It was the largest table-game jackpot in Arizona history. 
Steve Wynn Sells Off Homes A detailed article on ManajonGlobal com reports that Steve Wynn is continuing to

liquidate personal residences, described as a "huge swath of real estate," around the country for a total of more than \$300 million. Wynn sold his Las Vegas mansion, which he bought for \$13 million in 2018 after he was asked to leave his villa on the Wynn Resort golf course, for \$17.5 million last June; he dropped the asking price from \$25 million after it sat on the market awhile. The 11-bedroom home he bought in Beverly Hills in 2015 for \$48 million remains listed after a year for \$100 million, a \$25 million reduction from the original price. Now, according to the article, Wynn is selling two adjacent properties in Sun Valley, Idaho, for S27 million, as well as the next in a string of bought-and-sold residences in Palm Beach, where he lives, for \$78.5 million, and a New York City penthouse for \$90 million.

Tax Tips - Part I

If you are lucky enough to win some cash from the slots, or any bet, don't forget that Uncle Sam wants his cut too. So, before you run out and spend your jacknot here are four of the eight things to remember about taxes on gambling winnings. Look for Part II next month! (1) You Have to Report All Your Winnings: Whether it's \$5 or \$5,000, from the track, an office pool, a casino or a gambling website, all gambling winnings must be reported on your tax return as "other income" on Schedule 1 (Form 1040). If you win a non-cash prize, such as a car or a trip, report its fair market value as income. And, please, make sure you report all your gambling rinnings. If you won \$500, report \$500. The IRS isn't hunting down small-time

of yourself as a tax cheat. (2) You Might Get a Form W-2G: Generally, you'll receive an IRS Form W-2G if your gambling winnings are at least \$600 and the payout is at least 300 times the amount of your wager. The thresholds are \$1,200 for bingo or slot machine winnings, \$1,500 for keno winnings and \$5,000 for poker tournament winnings (and the payout doesn't have to be 300 times the wager for these types of winnings). Your reportable

vinnings will be listed in Box 1 of the If a W-2G is required, the payer (sports betting parlor, casino, racetrack, lottery, etc.) will need to see two forms. of identification. One of them must be a photo ID. You'll also have to provide your Social Security number or, if you have one, an individual taxpayer identification

W-2G form

In some cases, you'll get the W-2G on the spot. Otherwise, for this year's winnings, the payer must send the form losses that are more than the winnings

to you by January 31, 2023. In any event, if your bet was with a casino, we're fairly certain you'll get the W-2G. (3) Withholding Might Be Required:

Generally, if you win more than \$5,000 on a wager and the payout is at least 300 times the amount of your bet, the IRS requires the payer to withhold 24% of your winnings for income taxes. (Special withholding rules apply winnings from bingo, keno, machines and poker tournaments.) The amount withheld will be listed in Box 4 of the W-2G form you'll receive. You'll also have to sign the W-2G stating, under penalty of periury, that the information

listed on the form is correct. When you file your 1040 next year include the amount withheld as federal income tax withheld. It will be subtracted from the tax you owe. You'll also have to attach the W-2G form to your return. Again, this is what to expect when you

plunk down a bet at a casino, racetrack, sports betting parlor, or with some other legally operated gaming business; don't expect your buddy or the guy in accounting who's running an office pool to withhold taxes (although, technically, they should)

(4) Your Losses Might Be Deductible: Did you have a bad night at the blackiack table or pick the wrong horse to win? There's a possible silver lining if you lose a bet or two-vour gambling losses might be deductible. (Gambling losses include the actual cost of wagers plus related expenses such as travel to and from a casino or other cambling establishment)

There are a couple of important catches, though. First, unless you're a professional gambler, you have to itemize in order deduct gambling losses (itemized deductions are claimed on Schedule A. Unfortunately, most people don't itemize. So, if you claim the standard deduction. you're out of luck twice-once for losing your bet and once for not being able to deduct your gambling losses.

Second, you can't deduct gambling

you report on your return. For example, if you won \$100 on one bet but lost \$300 on a few others, you can only deduct the first \$100 of losses. If you were totally down on your luck and had absolutely no gambling winnings for the year, you can't

deduct any of your losses. If you're a professional gambler, you can deduct your losses as business expenses on Schedule C without having to itemize. However, a note of caution An activity only qualifies as a business if your primary purpose is to make a profit and you're continually and regularly involved in it. Sporadic activities of hobbies don't qualify as a business.
